Mayor Attends Groundbreaking for La Joya Villages Affordable Rental Apartments

Mayor Priscilla Taylor was a guest speaker at a ground-breaking ceremony held March 28 for the La Joya Villages Apartments, an affordable rental community under construction at 1105 6th Avenue South in Lake Worth.

La Joya Villages will consist of spacious two- and three- bedroom apartment homes with tile flooring throughout, Energy Star-rated appliances, hurricane impact windows and doors, and modern kitchen and bath fixtures. Resident amenities will include a splash park, community garden, gas barbecue grills, history labyrinth, and on-site property management.

The project is being developed by the Community Land Trust of Palm Beach County, Inc. and Realtex Development Southeast. The Board of County Commissioners awarded \$600,000 toward the financing of the project from HUD's HOME Investment Partnerships Program.

The units are expected to be available for occupancy beginning

in August and will be marketed to low-income families, with preference given to military veterans.
