The 63-unit townhome-style family rental complex is located at 5219 Melaleuca Lane in suburban Lake Worth.

Situated in the county's urban redevelopment area, the \$13 million project was financed with more than \$5.5 million in U.S. Dept. of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Neighborhood Stabilization and HOME Program loan funds, bond financing issued through the Housing Finance Authority of Palm Beach County and Citi Community Capital, and housing tax credit funds through Raymond James.

Half of the units will be reserved for households earning no more than 50 percent of area median income (AMI). HUD has determined that the AMI for a family of four in Palm Beach County is \$64,600.
