RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, VACATING A UTILITY EASEMENT LOCATED BETWEEN LOTS 1 AND 10, BLOCK 2, FROST PARK, AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 23. PAGE 188. PUBLIC RECORDS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida, pursuant to authority in Sections 177.101 and 336.09, Florida Statutes, and Ordinance No. 71-3, known as the Palm Beach County Road Abandonment and Plat Vacation Ordinance and upon the petition of Mr. Jacob Frant, President of Temple B'nai Jacob of Palm Springs, owners of property, for the vacation of a 6 foot utility easement hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, this Petition substantially complies with the terms and conditions of the vacation as set forth in said Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, this Board while convened in regular session on the 8th day of February, 1983 did hold a meeting on said Petition to vacate, and this Board having determined that said easement is in excess of the requirements of the local utility companies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby reaffirmed and ratified.
- 2. The following described Utility Easement is hereby vacated and closed as a public easement and this Board does hereby renounce and disclaim any right or interest of Palm Beach County and the Public in and to the following easement:

Being the platted Six Foot Utility Easement located between Lots 1 and 10; less the West 10 feet thereof, Block 2, Frost Park, Recorded in Plat Book 23, Page 188, Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida.

3. Notice of the adoption of this Resolution shall be published once in the Palm Beach Post Times within thirty (30) days of the date of adoption of this Resolution in accordance with Section 336.10, Florida Statutes and Ordinance No. 71-3.
