

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that FRED L. PADDOCK and MARY N. PADDOCK, his wife, and JAMES M. BUTLER, and MARGARET W. BUTLER, his wife, Owners of the tract of land lying and being in Palm Beach County, Florida, shown hereon, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 36, Township 43 South, Range 42 East, run thence easterly 670.17 feet along the East and West centerline of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter to a point; thence making an angle of 89° 51' 53" from West to South, run southerly (10) feet to a point on the South line of Golf Street; thence making an angle of 90° 08' 07" from North to West, run westerly 30.17 feet to a point; thence making an angle of 269° 53' 16" from East to South, run southerly 310' to a point on the South line of Wakely Street; thence making an angle of 90° 06' 44" from North to West, run westerly 640 feet along the South line of Wakely Street, to a point on the North & South centerline of Section 36, Township 43 South, Range 43 East, which point is on the centerline of Military Trail; thence, making an angle of 89° 53' 16" from East to North, run northerly 320' to the point of beginning, the last course forming with the first course an angle of 90° 06' 44", being Block 5 COUNTRY CLUB ADDITION NO. 2, Plat Book 15, Page 25.

Also, beginning at a point on the East & West centerline of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter, 640 feet East of the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 36, Township 43 South, Range 42 East, run thence easterly along said centerline 397.21 feet to a point; thence southwesterly, making an angle of 89° 53' 16" from North to South, a distance of 104 feet to the P.R.M. of a curve to the North & South centerline of Section 36, Township 43 South, Range 42 East, which point is on the East & West centerline of Wakely Street; and run thence southwesterly along said curve a distance of 521.27 feet to a point; thence making an angle of 89° 53' 16" from the tangent of said curve produced, Northeast to North, run northerly 320 feet to the point of beginning, the last course forming with the first course an angle of 90° 06' 44", and all angles mentioned herein being contained within the tract described.

have caused the same to be surveyed and replatted as shown hereon, and do hereby dedicate to the perpetual use of the public the Streets and Military Trail, as shown on the attached plat, reserving however unto themselves their heirs or legal representatives the reversion, or reversions thereof whenever the same shall be abandoned by the public or discontinued by law.
