

Lift Station as shown are for the construction, operation and maintenance of water and sewer facilities and is hereby dedicated in perpetuity to the ACME IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT and is the perpetual maintenance obligation of said District, its successors and assigns without recourse to Palm Beach County, Florida.

5. Roadway Tract "A" is for private road purposes, utilities and drainage, and is hereby dedicated in perpetuity to HUNTERS CHASE HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC. and is the perpetual maintenance obligation of said Association, its successors and assigns without recourse to Palm Beach County, Florida.

6. The Limited Access Easements as shown are hereby dedicated to the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners


