Rain barrels and cisterns have been used around the world for thousands of years and the time as come for Palm Beach County homeowners to enjoy their benefits.

Rainwater harvesting is always beneficial, whether the water is used to water one houseplant or an entire garden. Also, the act of collecting rainwater can be an inspiration to find other ways to conserve water around the home.

At this exciting educational presentation we will be building a rain barrel out of 50- to 55-gallon food-grade drums that were used to carry food products, such as juices, olives, pickles, etc.



Program participants will receive a presentation of how to construct different styles of rain barrels and pre-constructed barrels will be given out to each participant at the end of the program. Come and learn about water conservation through rainwater collection and take home a pre-built rain barrel for only \$50.00
