Do you have any problems with the landscape in your community? Is your turf grass having a hard time with the drought and now the abundant rains? Are your shrubs losing leaves to pests or fungus? Are trees growing too close to the buildings, causing liability if we were to have a wind event? Are you upgrading or downgrading your landscaping and just need advice? If so we may be able to help.

The Palm Beach County Cooperative Extension Service, a partnership of the University of Florida's Institute of Food and Agricultural Sciences and Palm Beach County Government has services that you may not know exist, and that may benefit your community. One such service is site visitations by our Florida Yards and Neighborhoods Program Coordinator to assist with information about any and all plant problem, pest, plant disease and other landscape related issues you may have.

These visits are limited to Condominium Communities and Home Owner Associations. We require that key members of your management team, landscapers and committee members must be present. Our schedule is very busy, so please contact us well in advance of desired meeting dates. Give us a call and we can explain all the details to you and see if this service will work for your community.

Site visits are a no cost service to your community that may be very beneficial to make yourself, your owners and landscapers aware of the most up to date advice that the University of Florida can offer.

We also offer presentations to boards, committees and other groups that may assist with the landscapes of your community. We are here to help and are happy to assist in any way that we can. 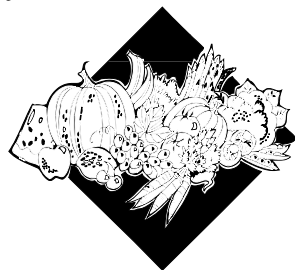
