The Palm Beach County Criminal Justice Commission (CJC) announces the **21st Citizen's Criminal Justice Academy**. The Academy is a **free** 6-week course, held each Tuesday and Thursday, from 6:00-8:00 p.m. beginning September 25, 2008 through October 30, 2008.

Course Description

The Academy was created by the Criminal Justice Commission to educate citizens about the criminal justice system. It covers all aspects of the criminal justice system and provides students with a good general knowledge of how the system functions from the perspective of criminal justice professionals. The 6 week course will be held at the **West Palm Beach Police Department, located at 600 Banyan Avenue in West Palm Beach, FL.** There will also be numerous tours at other criminal justice locations in the County, including the Main Detention Center and the Medical Examiner's Office. In addition, there will be demonstrations from the Mounted Unit, PBSO Helicopter Unit, and the Crime Scene Investigator. Presentations will be given by Palm Beach County Sheriff Ric Bradshaw, Juvenile and County Court judges, the State Attorney, Public Defender, juvenile corrections personnel, Mayor Frankel of West Palm Beach, and other criminal justice officials.
