What Is NENA?

- **NENA** is an outdoor destination bringing together over *165,000 acres* of wild Florida lands and more than *12* different activity & education centers
- **NENA** provides a wide range of outdoor recreational activities from bird watching in an area open only to foot traffic to hunting in areas open to off-road vehicles.
- **NENA's** trail network offers access and connections to several different conservation lands while providing alternative routes for transportation.
- **NENA** is a working partnership with many different governmental and private organizations that manage the **NENA** places.

Where is the Trail?

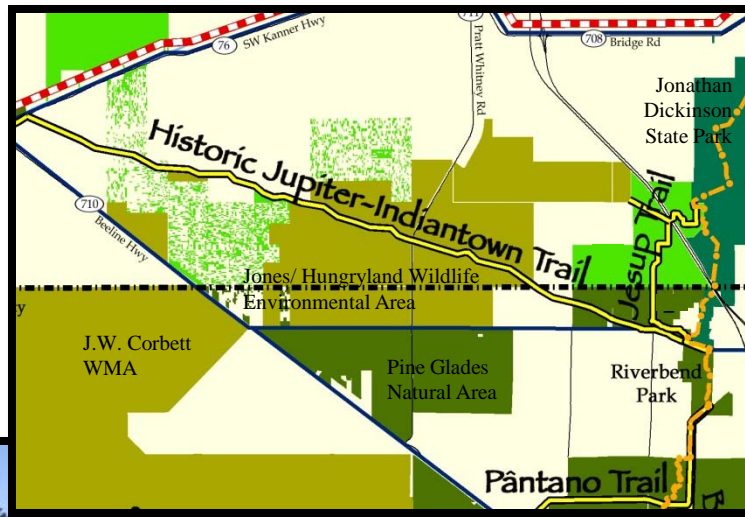
- Historic Jupiter Indiantown Trail extends **16.5 miles** from Riverbend Park in Jupiter to the St. Lucie Canal in Indiantown.
- Phase 1 extends for **2 miles** through Cypress Creek Natural Area.

- Selected for \$750K FDOT Florida Stimulus Scenic Enhancement Funds

Project Features Phase 1

- Total **2 miles** of hardened, improved trail
- Chickee shade shelter and other amenities
- Horse hitches and bike racks at trailheads within Cypress Creek Natural Area
- Shared-use access for equestrians, bicycles and pedestrians
- Educational kiosks and signs

Status

Phase 1 Construction
Scheduled for Spring 2010

5 miles currently **OPEN** off Pratt Whitney Rd. to hikers, bikers & equestrians

Project Benefits

- Restores an old connection between Jupiter and Indiantown
- Offers backcountry shared-use access from Riverbend Park to Cypress Creek Natural Area and Jones/Hungryland WEA
- Improved trail in Cypress Creek Natural and Management Areas provides greater access to other backcountry trails
- Preserves historic route for future interpretive trail rides
