Connecting **NENA** Places

## What Is NENA?

- **NENA** is an outdoor destination bringing together over *165,000* acres of wild Florida lands and more than 12 different activity & education centers
- **NENA** provides a wide range of outdoor recreational activities from bird watching in an area open only to foot traffic to hunting in areas open to off-road vehicles.
- **NENA's** trail network offers access and connections to several different conservation lands while providing alternative routes for transportation.
- **NENA** is a working partnership with many different governmental and private organizations that manage the **NENA** places.

## Where is the Trail?

- Jesup Trail extends **6 miles** from Riverbend Park in Jupiter north to Jonathan Dickinson State Park in Hobe Sound.

## Project Features

- Total **6 miles** of hardened, improved trail
- Chickee shade shelter and other amenities
- Horse hitches and bike racks at trailheads in County Natural Areas
- Educational kiosks and signs
- Shared-use access for equestrians, bicycles and pedestrians

## Project Benefits

- Provides alternate transportation route from Riverbend Park in Jupiter to Jonathan Dickinson State Park in Hobe Sound
- Offers backcountry multi-use access to the Cypress Creek Natural Area, Cypress Creek Management Area, Jones/Hungryland WEA, and Jonathan Dickinson State Park
- Opportunities to view rare hardwood communities and black water creeks that feed the Loxahatchee River
