## \*IMPORTANT NOTICE\*

March 13, 2024

Dear Industry Stakeholders:

On March 12, 2024, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) adopted the amended Equal Business Opportunity (EBO) Ordinance to increase the gross revenue size standards for small business enterprises (SBE). The new standards are as follows:

Construction: \$13 million

CCNA Professional Services: \$7 million

Non-CCNA Professional Services: \$5.7 million

Goods: \$7 million

Other Services: \$5.7 million

In addition, SBEs that graduate while working on a contract with a Small, Minority and/or Women Business participation goal will count towards the established goal for the life of the contract and until the contract ends.

If your annual revenue, averaged over the past three (3) years, does not exceed the newly revised size standards, you are eligible to apply for certification. A notification will be placed on the EBO website when the amendment is effective and when you may submit your application. The EBO website is Office of Equal Business Opportunity Home (pbcgov.org).

Applications for certification may take up to ninety (90) business days to review and may be expedited to a twenty (20) business day review for a \$300.00 fee. You can find instructions to submit your electronic application on the EBO website under the Documents tab.
