

Ana, Bill, Claudette, Danny, Elsa 2021 Hurricane Season

The 2021 hurricane season is quickly approaching and Palm Beach County is working to ensure the safety of your business. Hurricane season is generally from June 1 to November 30. However, it is important that you create a plan of action that includes a business continuity plan ahead of time. As a business owner, you should assess what matters the most. This means protecting your employees, making an inventory of assets, backing up important data, implementing communications systems, mapping out evacuation routes, and monitoring the news and information released by the county.

While no amount of preparation can control the damage from a storm, we know advanced planning can minimize the impact. The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration predicts there will be between 13–20 named storms this season. About five of these storms will be Category 3 or higher. "Now is the time for communities along the coastline as well as inland to get prepared for the dangers that hurricanes can bring," said Secretary of Commerce Gina Raimondo. "The experts at NOAA are poised to deliver life-saving early warnings and forecasts to communities, which will also help minimize the economic impacts of storms."

HURRICANE FAQ

Q: How do hurricanes form?

A: Hurricanes only form over really warm ocean water of 80°F or warmer. The atmosphere (the air) must cool off very quickly the higher you go. Also, the wind must be blowing in the same direction and at the same speed to force air upward from the ocean surface. Winds flow outward above the storm allowing the air below to rise. Hurricanes typically form between 5 to 15 degrees latitude north and south of the equator. The Coriolis Force is needed to create the spin in the hurricane and it becomes too weak near the equator, so hurricanes can never form there.

Q: How can I prepare for a hurricane?

A: The best time to prepare is before hurricane season begins. Make a plan for you and your family about what to do if a hurricane threatens. Put together a hurricane kit. Ensure your house is up to code, and check for problems, such as overhanging branches or missing roof tiles. Check your shutters and other window and door coverings. Once the season begins, stay informed. Check the outlook every day, and if anything is threatening keep updated on the latest advisories. Q: What is the difference between a hurricane watch and a hurricane warning?

A: *Hurricane Watch* - A Hurricane Watch is an announcement that hurricane force winds are **possible** within the specified area in association with a tropical cyclone. A hurricane watch is issued 48 hours in advance of the anticipated onset.

Hurricane Warning - Hurricane warnings are issued 36 hours in advance and are announced when hurricane force winds are **expected** somewhere within the specified area in association with a cyclone. This warning can remain in effect in the face of other hazards, such as flooding even if the winds drop to below hurricane force.

Communities, families, and individuals should know what to do in the event of a disaster and where to seek shelter. They should be ready to evacuate their homes, take refuge in public shelters, and know how to care for their basic medical needs. PBC DART provides tools for preparedness through several APP Features.

D.A.R.T. provides the ability to review evacuation orders and the current status of local shelters. The *"Make a Plan"* feature includes essential information for the development of a disaster preparedness plan, while the **"Build a Kit"** feature displays information on topics such as emergency supply kit, food, water, storage, health, first aid, medication, cleaning, and other supplies. Preparedness is a responsibility that we all share, learn first aid and C.P.R., and volunteer. Become a CERT member.

"Recovery" features include Grocery & Building Store locations, generators, and closures. As well as Gas Station opening and closures in the surrounding areas. Having the ability to report damage is critical. The PBC DART App provides those provisions information is gathered via the app is automatically updated to WebEOC ensuring damage is reported. With the inclusion of the social media feature, D.A.R.T. allows access to updates and important information from your county's Emergency Management Twitter feed.

Become Pre-Qualified!!!

Pre-qualification contracts are a great opportunity for new or existing vendors to bid smaller projects in order to become familiar with the County's processes and to establish a solid working relationship with the County!

A pre-qualification contract is a contract that includes minimum qualifications (e.g., references, licenses, experience, etc.) required from the vendor in order for them to become pre-qualified on a contract for goods and/or services where two or more qualified vendors compete for specific projects. The County will add vendors to the pre-qualification contract at any time as long as the vendor meets the minimum qualifications stated in the pre-qualification package. Purchases solicited through a pre-qualification contract are generally under \$100,000.

Palm Beach County's Purchasing and Facilities Development & Operations Departments have an assortment of pre-qualification contracts available for a variety of different services that are utilized by multiple departments within Palm Beach County. 



PALM BEACH COUNTY Water Utilities Department

In the last fifty years, Palm Beach County has seen remarkable growth and with it; change; but the Water Utilities Department's (WUD) commitment to its customers and the business community has remained constant. As the department celebrates its 51st year in business, it welcomes Mr. Ali Bayat, PE, PMP, taking the reins at the helm as the Department Director. While Mr. Bayat is new to this position, his years of previous utilities experience working his way up the ranks at WUD will allow for a seamless transition.

Part of Mr. Bayat's focus is to continue to promote inclusion and diversity in the Two recent top management staff. appointments included Krystin Berntsen, PE, PMP to fill the position of Deputy Director and Stephanie Marsh-Corinthian as Assistant Director to oversee Finance, Customer Service and Human Resources. Bayat's mission is also to mirror diversity inside the organization by cultivating more external partnerships with minority and womenowned businesses. so that the department continues to exceed the county Small, Minority and Women Owned Business Enterprise (S/MWBE) goals and statistics.



Background

WUD is the 3rd largest water utility in the State of Florida, employing 652 staff responsible for providing safe, high quality drinking water and wastewater services to approximately 560,000 customers 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The 5 regional water plants and 3 wastewater plants are strategically located across the county from Boca Raton to Northlake Boulevard, and from Atlantis to the Glades. The department also supplies reclaimed water service to the south-central area of the County, with a capacity of 22 million gallons per day. To get an idea of the general size of the service area, if the 4,400 miles of piping infrastructure were placed together end to end; it would stretch from West Palm Beach to London, England.

Water Utilities' robust Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) consists of over \$500 million in infrastructure improvements of construction and design services over the next five years. Typical CIP services contracted by WUD include:

Professional Services:

Civil design, water and wastewater treatment facilities, pipelines and wastewater lift stations Cost estimating and scheduling Electrical and instrumentation design Engineering services during construction Hydrogeological design for wells Master planning and studies Mechanical design of piping and pumps Site planning and zoning Surveying Underground utility 'locates' including soft digs and ground-penetrating radar Other services such as demolition, hauling, surveying, etc.

Pipelines: raw water, potable water, gravity sewer, force main, and reclaimed water Lift station rehabilitation of civil, mechanical, and electrical systems. Rehabilitation and construction of production wells Instrumentation and controls Water treatment plant improvements Wastewater treatment facility improvements Site civil such as pavement and/or driveway restoration, sidewalks, curb and gutter, sod and

landscape

Other services such as demolition, hauling, surveying, etc.



Looking to the Future

Recognized for its environmental stewardship, the department is currently embarking on an expansion of its Green Cay Wetlands to include a state of the art Educational Center along with a 63-acre park to provide additional forms of recreation, including kayaking, picnic areas, extended boardwalks for bird watching, and shaded fitness areas. A conceptual plan for the expansion is provided below.
