The Association of Inspectors General (AIG) conducted an on-site peer review of the Palm Beach County Office of Inspector General (OIG) from September 13 -15, 2021. We are proud to announce that on September 16, 2021 our office received notice that the AIG peer review team unanimously concluded that the OIG's Audit and Contract Oversight and Evaluations Divisions met all relevant Government Auditing Standards and AIG Quality Standards for Offices of Inspector General.



The AIG is a non-profit, membership organization for agencies and professionals in the inspector general community. The mission of the AIG is to promote excellence in the inspector general community by establishing and encouraging adherence to quality standards for each of the specific professional disciplines.



On February 18, 2021, our office was re-accredited by the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation (CFA). The CFA assessors main focus was on our Investigation Division and found the OIG to be 100% in compliance with the applicable standards set by CFA.

External peer reviews and accreditations by independent reviewing authorities ensure OIGs meet specific requirements and prescribed standards. These are one way the OIG assures the public it maintains the highest standards of professionalism in promoting integrity, accountability, and transparency in local government.
