



Equestrian Trails Rules and Regulations

All users are hereby advised that this Open Riding Area is an unsupervised recreational area. All users are advised that the use of this facility is at their own risk.

Failure to comply with rules and regulations may result in the revocation of permit and privileges.

- Trails are for equestrian use only
- All riders must obtain a permit from the facility management office. Proof of negative Coggings test is required. Permits are free of charge and good for one calendar year
- Trail riding hours are sunrise to sunset. Please allow enough time to return to your vehicle
- Riders 16 years of age and younger are required to wear an approved safety helmet and must be accompanied by an adult
- Racing is prohibited. Horses should not run, but navigate the trails at a slow and safe pace
- Please keep horses on designated riding trails
- Alcohol is prohibited on trails
- Please make sure you bring sufficient water and carry out all litter
- No buddy seats, riding double, or bareback riding
- Dogs are prohibited on trails
- Trailers are not to be unhooked on asphalt roadways
