Summary: Resolution No. R-77-723, as amended by R-90-1992A and R-93-276 established the Animal Care Advisory Board. Resolution R-2005-1609, dated August 16, 2005 restructured the membership and created the Animal Care & Control Professional Committee. The committee is comprised of representatives for the following agencies: Palm Beach County Veterinary Society; United States Department of Agriculture; Palm Beach County Sheriff' Office; Fish and Wildlife Conservation Committee; and the Palm Beach County Health Department. There are also two (2) "At-Large" positions. The Committee's role will be to discuss matters relating to animal care, animal health issues, public health and safety concerns, and to listen to matters brought forth by the public.

Background and Justification:

Ms. Davis is the former Executive Director of the Peggy Adams Animal Rescue League in West Palm Beach. She held this position from 1995 until 2003. Sue Drawdy served on the Animal Care & Control Advisory Board from 1997, her last year as Chairperson. She is co-founder of Rising Star Rottweiler Rescue, Inc and is a founding member of the Palm Beach County Horse Industry Council. Linda Gore served on the Animal Care & Control Advisory Board for several years and also serves on the boards of A.S.K.K and Save-A-Pet, Inc. Nanci Alexander is the president of the Animal Rights Foundation of Florida and served on the Animal Care & Control Advisory Board for several years. Nick Atwood is a writer/web designer very interested in animal issues and has expressed a desire to serve on the board.
