**Summary:** At its October 3, 2006 meeting the Board approved a resolution (R2006-2138) establishing the Budget Advisory Committee, appointing Commissioner Newell chairman and directing staff to present this agenda item to appoint six members. The resolution requires a super majority vote to approve each appointee who will represent the district on the Committee. The members are required to "possess special expertise and experience in business or government". The resolution states that the first two appointees will serve three year terms, the second two appointees will serve two year terms and the last two appointees will serve one year terms. The resolution also states that the Commissioner serving as Chair will not have an appointment to the Committee. (Countywide PFK)

**Background and Justification:** The Committee's focus is limited to projects and programs funded by Countywide ad valorem taxes. The Committee is to provide advice in identifying areas where the need for increased efficiency is greatest, and analyze and review organization, management, business practices and procedures of County government.
