I.EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

1 mr - 40

- A. An Amendment to Agreement R2006-0300, dated February 28, 2006, in the amount of \$35,000, that will increase the amount reimbursed to the Town of South Palm Beach for street lighting along SR A1A/Ocean Boulevard.
- B. A Budget Transfer of \$35,000 in the Transportation Improvement Fund from Reserve for District 4 to Town of South Palm Beach A-1-A/Ocean Boulevard District 4.

Summary: This Amendment and Budget Transfer will increase by \$35,000 the amount reimbursed to the Town for installation of street lights along SR A-1-A/Ocean Boulevard to \$95,000.

District: 4 (MRE)

Background and Justification: The Town is undertaking the installation of street lights along SR A-1-A/Ocean Boulevard within Town limits. The Town requested financial assistance through the District 4 Commissioner. The District 4 Commissioner provided initial funding of \$60,000 on February 28, 2006 (R2006-0300). The District 4 Commissioner wishes to increase the funding for the project by \$35,000, bringing the total reimbursement for the project to \$95,000. The Town will be responsible for maintenance of the project after installation.



INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND THE TOWN OF SOUTH PALM BEACH FOR INSTALLATION OF STREET LIGHTS ALONG SR-A1A/OCEAN BOULEVARD

R2006 0300

THIS INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT is made and entered into the 2 mag day of _____, by and between PALM BEACH COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY" and THE TOWN OF SOUTH PALM BEACH, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida hereinafter referred to as "TOWN"

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the TOWN is undertaking the installation of street lights along SR-A1A/Ocean Boulevard within the TOWN limits hereinafter referred to as "PROJECT"; and

WHEREAS, the PROJECT consists of installation of decorative light poles, landscape lighting, pull boxes, pole distribution systems, underground cable and conduit for street lighting along SR-A1A/Ocean Boulevard, within the TOWN limits; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY believes that the PROJECT to provide decorative lights for this street serves a public purpose in the enhancement of the TOWN and wishes to support the PROJECT by providing supplemental reimbursement funding for the documented costs of the PROJECT in an amount not to exceed SIXTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$60,000.00); and

WHEREAS, after the installation of the PROJECT, the TOWN will be responsible for the subsequent maintenance of the STREET LIGHTS.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises, and agreements herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are true, correct and incorporated herein.
- 2. The COUNTY agrees to provide to the TOWN reimbursement funding for documented costs of the PROJECT in an amount not to exceed SIXTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$60,000.00).
- 3. The COUNTY agrees to reimburse the TOWN the amount established in paragraph 2 for costs associated with the PROJECT, upon the TOWN's submission of acceptable documentation needed to substantiate its cost for the PROJECT. The COUNTY will use its best efforts to provide said funds to the TOWN on

a reimbursement basis within forty-five (45) days of receipt of all information required in paragraph 6, below.

- 4. The **COUNTY's** obligation is limited to its payment obligation and shall have no obligation to any other person or entity.
- 5. The **TOWN** agrees to assume all responsibility for design, bidding, contract preparation, and contract administration necessary for the **PROJECT**, including payment(s) to contractor(s) pursuant to all applicable governmental laws and regulations.
- 6. The **TOWN** will obtain or provide all labor and materials necessary for the **PROJECT**. The **TOWN** shall furnish to the **COUNTY's** representative a request for payment supported by the following:

A Contract Payment Request Form and a Contractual Services Purchases Schedule Form, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A" (pages 1 & 2), which are required for each and every reimbursement to the TOWN. Said information shall list each invoice payable by the TOWN and shall include the vendor invoice number, invoice date, and the amount payable by the COUNTY. The TOWN shall attach a copy of each vendor invoice paid by the TOWN along with a copy of the respective check and shall make reference thereof to the applicable item listed on the Contractual Services Purchases Schedule Form. Further, the TOWN's Financial Officer shall also certify that each invoice listed on the Contractual Services Purchases Schedule Form was paid by the TOWN as indicated.

- 7. As it relates to this Agreement, the **COUNTY** may initiate a financial systems analysis and/or an internal fiscal control evaluation of the **TOWN** by an independent auditing firm employed by the **COUNTY** or by the County Internal Audit Department at any time the **COUNTY** deems necessary.
- 8. The **TOWN** agrees to be responsible for the subsequent maintenance of the **PROJECT** following installation. The **TOWN** shall be solely responsible for obtaining and complying with all necessary permits, approvals and authorizations from any federal, state, regional, **COUNTY** or agency which are required for the **PROJECT**.
- 9. The **PROJECT** shall be completed and final invoices submitted to the **COUNTY** no later than December 31, 2007, and the **COUNTY** shall have no obligation to the **TOWN** or any other entity or person for any cost incurred thereafter unless the time for completion is extended by modification of this Agreement.

- 10. Each party shall be liable for its own actions and negligence and to the extent permitted by law, the **TOWN** shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the **COUNTY** against any actions, claims or damages arising out of the **TOWN**'s negligence in connection with this Agreement or the performance by the **TOWN** as it may relate to this Agreement. The foregoing indemnification shall not constitute a waiver of sovereign immunity beyond the limits set forth in Florida Statutes, Section 786.28, nor shall the same be construed to constitute agreement by either party to indemnify the other party for such other party's negligence, willful or intentional acts or omissions.
- 11. The **TOWN** shall, at all times during the term of this Agreement, maintain appropriate insurance.
- 12. As provided in F.S. 287.132-133, by entering into this Agreement or performing any work in furtherance hereof, the **TOWN** certifies that its affiliates, suppliers, sub-contractors, and consultants who perform work hereunder, have not been placed on the convicted vendor list maintained by the State of Florida Department of Management Services within 36 months immediately preceding the date hereof. This notice is required by F.S. 287.133(3)(a).
- 13. The **TOWN** shall require each contractor engaged by the **TOWN** for work associated with this Agreement to maintain:

Workers' Compensation coverage in accordance with Florida Statutes, and;

- a. Commercial General Liability coverage, including vehicle coverage, in combined single limits of not less than ONE MILLION DOLLARS
 (\$1,000,000.00). The COUNTY shall be included in the coverage as an additional insured.
- b. A payment and performance bond for the total amount of the **PROJECT** in accordance with Florida Statute 255.05.
- 14. In the event of termination, the **TOWN** shall not be relieved of liability to the **COUNTY** for damages sustained by the **COUNTY** by virtue of any breach of the Agreement by the **TOWN**; and the **COUNTY** may withhold any payment to the **TOWN** for the purpose of set-off until such time as the exact amount of damages due the **COUNTY** is determined.
- 15. The **TOWN**'s termination of this Agreement shall result in all obligations of the **COUNTY** for funding contemplated herein to be cancelled.

- 16. The **COUNTY** and **TOWN** agree that no person shall, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sexual orientation, religion or creed, sex, age, or handicap be discriminated against in performance of this Agreement.
- 17. In the event that any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or provision hereof is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the remaining portions of this Agreement and the same shall remain in full force and effect.
- 18. All notices required to be given under this Agreement shall be in writing, and deemed sufficient to each party when sent by United States Mail, postage paid, to the following:

- 19. This Agreement shall be construed and governed by the laws of the State of Florida. Any legal action necessary to enforce this Agreement shall be held in Palm Beach County. No remedy herein conferred upon any party is intended to be exclusive of any other remedy, and each and every other remedy shall be cumulative and shall be in addition to every other remedy given hereunder or now hereafter existing at law or in equity or by statute or otherwise. No single or partial exercise by any party of any right, power or remedy shall preclude any other or further exercise thereof.
- 20. Any costs or expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees) associated with the enforcement of the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall be borne by the respective parties; provided, however, that this clause pertains only to the parties to the Agreement.
- 21. Except as expressly permitted herein to the contrary, no modification, amendment, or alteration in the terms or conditions contained herein shall be

effective unless contained in a written document executed with the same formality and equality of dignity herewith.

- 22. Each party agrees to abide by all laws, orders, rules and regulations and the TOWN will comply with all applicable governmental codes during the PROJECT.
- Each party shall promptly notify the other of any lawsuit-related complaint, or cause of action threatened or commenced against it which arises out of or relates, in any manner, to the performance of this Agreement.
- 24. The parties expressly covenant and agree that in the event any of the parties is in default of its obligations under this Agreement, the parties not in default shall provide to the defaulting party thirty (30) days written notice before exercising any of their rights.
- 25. The preparation of this Agreement has been a joint effort of the parties, and the resulting document shall not solely as a matter of judicial constraint, be construed more severely against one of the parties than the other.
- 26. This Agreement represents the entire understanding among the parties, and supercedes all other negotiations, or agreements, either written or oral, relating to this Agreement.
- 27. The County will file a copy of this Agreement with the Clerk of the Circuit Court in and for Palm Beach County, Florida.
- 28. This Agreement shall take effect upon execution and the effective date shall be the date of execution.

AMENDMENT # 1 TO THE INTER-LOCAL AGREEMENT DATED FEBRUARY 28, 2006 WITH THE TOWN OF SOUTH PALM BEACH FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF COSTS FOR INSTALLATION OF STREET LIGHTS ALONG SR-AIA/OCEAN BOULEVARD

THIS AMENDMENT is made to the Inter-local Agreement (R2006-0300) dated February 28, 2006 with the Town of South Palm Beach, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter "TOWN", and the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSINERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter "COUNTY".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2006, the TOWN and the COUNTY entered into an Inter-local Agreement (R2006-0300) providing for COUNTY funding of the installation of street lights along SR-A1A/Ocean Boulevard by the TOWN in an amount not to exceed SIXTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$60,000.00) and;

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2006, the COUNTY provided for funding of the street lights in an amount not to exceed \$60,000.00 with the TOWN that provided a completion date of December 31, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the District Commissioner has requested that the funding amount be increased by an additional \$35,000.00 to \$95,000.00 and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and TOWN desire that this Amendment shall relate back to February 28, 2006, and the Contract continued without interruption nor lapse and the funding increased to an amount not to exceed \$95,000.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual covenants, promises, and agreements herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The Inter-local Agreement dated February 28, 2006, by and between the COUNTY and TOWN shall be continued, without interruption nor lapse in its term or effect commencing February 28, 2006 and expiring December 31, 2007. The amount of the Agreement shall be increased by \$35,000.00 and shall not exceed the total amount of \$95,000.00. Accordingly, the Agreement is hereby amended to revise paragraph 2 as follows:
 - 2. The **COUNTY** agrees to provide the **TOWN** reimbursement funding for documented costs of the **IMPROVEMENTS** in an amount not to exceed **NINETY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS** (\$95,000.00).

- It is the intent of the parties hereto that this Amendment shall not become binding until the date executed by the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County.
- All other provisions of the Inter-local Agreement dated February 28, 2006, shall remain in full force and effect.
