I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF
Motion and Title:
Staff recommends a motion to approve and ratify : an addendum to the Collective bargaining Agreement, with the Professional Firefighters/Paramedics of Palm Beach County, Local #2928, IAFF, Inc.
SUMMARY: Both parties are requesting an addendum to the current Collective Bargaining Agreement, October 1, 2005 – September 30, 2008 (R2005-1908). This addendum addresses the terms and conditions of employment for the employees of Belle Glade, Pahokee, and South Bay Fire Departments, who became County employees on October 1, 2006. This addendum was developed jointly by Fire-Rescue staff and Union Leadership. Countywide (SB)
Background and Policy Issues:
On December 20, 2005, at the request of the City of Pahokee, the City of South Bay, and the City of Belle Glade, the Board adopted Ordinance 2005-064 which amended the boundaries of the Fire Rescue MSTU (Municipal Service Taxing Unit) to include these cities in the MSTU. Effective October 1, 2006, these cities abolished their fire departments and their employees became employees of the County.

ATTACHMENT # 1

ADDENDUM TO THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT

BATTALION 7 - BELLE GLADE, PAHOKEE, SOUTH BAY EMPLOYEES

SECTION 1.

It is agreed between the parties that all provisions of the Collective Bargaining Agreement (Master Agreement) between the County and the Union shall apply to the employees of the Belle Glade, Pahokee and South Bay Fire Departments, who will become County employees at 7:30 a.m. on October 1, 2006, except that the following provisions shall apply in lieu of conflicting provisions in the Master Agreement:

SECTION 2. ARTICLE 13 - SENIORITY

Seniority with the Belle Glade, Pahokee or South Bay Fire Department shall be considered as continuous in the same manner as a County employee from a predecessor fire district. Seniority shall be determined from the date of hire with the Belle Glade, Pahokee or South Bay Fire Department, if the employee was employed by the Belle Glade, Pahokee or South Bay Fire Department on September 30, 2006, and was employed by Palm Beach County on October 1, 2006.

SECTION 3. ARTICLE 18 - PROMOTIONS

Belle Glade, Pahokee or South Bay Fire Department employees shall be considered eligible to participate in the promotional procedures specified in the Master Agreement.

ATTACHMENT #2

For the purposes of time in grade required to be eligible for participation in a promotional process, the Belle Glade, Pahokee or South Bay Fire Department employees slotted as District Chiefs, Lieutenants or Driver Operators on October 1, 2006 shall have a date of promotion of October 1, 2006.

SECTION 4. ARTICLE 19 - PAY PLAN

The wages for the Belle Glade, Pahokee or South Bay Fire Department employees shall be based on the slotting set forth in the attached schedule. Thereafter, advancement through the appropriate pay plans shall be in accordance with the Master Agreement. Assignment and step-up pay shall be paid in accordance with the Master Agreement.

District Chiefs assigned to the Floating Squad who may be required to work in Battalion 7 shall be paid an additional 2% of their base pay for all hours worked within Battalion 7.

SECTION 5. ARTICLE 20 - WORK WEEK

The selection of Kelly Days for Battalion 7 personnel, including floaters, shall be determined by position and shift, on a battalion-wide basis, based on Department Seniority as defined in this Agreement. The Fire Rescue Administrator shall have the sole authority to determine the number of Lieutenants, Driver Operators, and Firefighters allowed off on Kelly Day, up to a total of three (3), which shall be implemented separate from the department-wide restrictions. It is anticipated that staffing levels will be increased in January, 2008 to facilitate

implementation of ALS/BLS transport services, and therefore Kelly Day limitations would be recalculated and included within the department-wide restrictions.

SECTION 6. ARTICLE 22 - EXCHANGE OF TIME

Battalion 7 employees shall be allowed to exchange time among themselves in accordance with this article, and with other County employees in accordance with this article and with the approval of the Battalion Chief responsible for Battalion 7. Any exchange of time which has been approved prior to September 30, 2006 must be repaid prior to October 1, 2006.

SECTION 7. ARTICLE 27 - UNIFORMS

Belle Glade, Pahokee and South Bay Fire Department employees shall be given an initial allocation of uniforms as specified in Section 1 of this Article. Effective October 1, 2007, Belle Glade, Pahokee or South Bay Fire Department employees shall receive a uniform credit.

SECTION 8. ARTICLE 28 - VACATIONS

Belle Glade, Pahokee or South Bay Fire Department employees may transfer up to 400 hours of accrued vacation time to Palm Beach County.

For the remainder of calendar year 2006, the County shall honor those vacation selections made prior to October 1, 2006, for Belle Glade, Pahokee or South Bay Fire Department employees, provided documentation of approval of the scheduled vacation is submitted prior to October 1, 2006. Employees may not schedule vacation in excess of their anticipated available accruals including existing banks.

For calendar year 2007 only, vacations shall be scheduled in accordance with the Master Agreement, except that up to one (1) officer, one (1) Driver Operator, and/or two (2) firefighters per shift shall be allowed off on vacation, up to a total of three (3).

SECTION 9. ARTICLE 34 - PENSION

Subject to the provisions of Chapters 121, Florida Statutes, and any other applicable Florida laws, all Belle Glade, Pahokee and South Bay Fire Department employees shall be enrolled as new employees under the Florida Retirement System, effective October 1, 2006.

SECTION 10. ARTICLE 43 - DURATION

It is understood by the parties that the provisions of this addendum shall remain in effect until otherwise specifically addressed by a modification of the Master Agreement.

SECTION 11. ARTICLE 45 - WELLNESS PROGRAM

Section A. Sick Leave - It is understood that prior to October 1, 2006, the cities of Belle Glade, Pahokee and South Bay shall eliminate all banks of sick leave. Accordingly, effective at 7:30 a.m. on October 1, 2006, Belle Glade, Pahokee and South Bay Fire Department employees shall come to the County with a zero (0) balance for sick leave. Effective at 7:30 a.m. on October 1, 2006, Belle Glade, Pahokee and South Bay Fire Department employees shall be credited with an appropriate proration of sick leave amounts based on the months remaining until the next allotment.

Section B. Medical Physicals - Prior to October 1, 2006, all employees covered by this addendum shall complete a pre-employment physical at the County Clinic, as well as fitness assessment with the Fire Department Exercise Physiologist. These employees shall not be required to participate in an additional physical and fitness assessment until January 1, 2007. Thereafter, these employees shall be required to complete annual physicals in accordance with the schedule contained in the Master Agreement.

SECTION 12. ASSIGNMENT OF EMPLOYEES

It is agreed between the parties that the employees covered by this addendum shall receive initial station bid assignments in accordance with the attached schedule. All employees shall be eligible to participate in the bid process in accordance with Palm Beach County Fire Rescue policies.

It is agreed that the following employees of South Bay Fire Department, hired after July 1, 2006, shall be required to successfully complete the Palm Beach County Fire Rescue Recruit Academy as a condition of continued employment:
