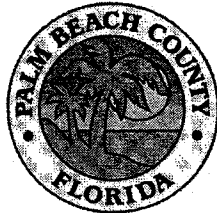

Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity Palm Beach County Emergency Medical Services

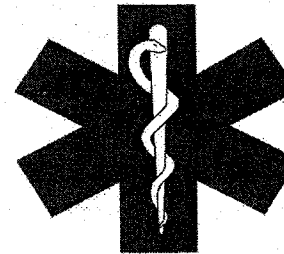




