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# FIRST AMENDMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND THE CITY OF LAKE WORTH FOR FUNDING OF LAKE WORTH WILDCATS LEAGUE EXPENSES

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT is entered into on	_, by and between Palm Beach
County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafte	er referred to as "County", and the
City of Lake Worth, a Florida municipal corporation hereinafte	er referred to as "Lake Worth"

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2006, County entered into an Agreement with Lake Worth (R-2006-1952), hereinafter referred to as "Agreement" to provide Recreation Assistance Program (RAP) funding in an amount not-to-exceed \$4,700 for equipment, operational expenses, officials costs, insurance, uniforms, and other miscellaneous expenses associated with Lake Worth Wildcats league expenses for football and cheerleading program, hereinafter referred to as the "Program"; and

WHEREAS, Lake Worth has requested that County increase the amount of funding for the Project to \$6,700; and

WHEREAS, the Project will benefit all citizens of Palm Beach County.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereby agree as follows:

- 1. The fifth Whereas clause of the Agreement shall be amended to state: "Lake Worth has requested that County provide \$6,700 to help offset expenses for the Program; and".
- 2. The seventh Whereas clause of the Agreement shall be amended to state: "Whereas, funding for Lake Worth in an amount not to exceed \$6,700 is available from the Recreation Assistance Program (RAP) District 7(\$4,700) and District 4 (\$2,000); and".
- 3. Section 1 of the Agreement shall be amended to state: "County agrees to fund an amount not to exceed \$6,700 to Lake Worth for equipment, operational expenses, officials costs, insurance, uniforms, and other miscellaneous expenses associated with the Program, as set forth in Exhibit 'A', attached hereto and incorporated herein, hereinafter referred to as the 'Project' ".
- 4. Except as provided herein, each and every other term of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and the Agreement is reaffirmed as modified herein.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, the parties, by and through their duly authorized agents, have hereunto set their hands and seals on the date indicated above.
