#### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: STAFF RECOMMENDS MOTION TO APPROVE: Change Order No. 3 in the amount of \$87,993.96, together with a  $68-\bar{d}ay$  time extension, to Contract No. R2006-0298 with Ranger Construction Industries, Inc. for construction of Melaleuca Lane from Jog Road to Haverhill Road.

Summary: Change Order No. 3 is compensation for additional costs and delays encountered due to maintenance of temporary traffic control at the Lake Worth Drainage District (LWDD) E-3 canal.

District: 2 (M.E.)

Background and Justification: After construction had commenced, it was discovered that two new homes and two new driveways had been constructed at the northeast corner of the bridge on Melaleuca Lane over the LWDD E-3 canal. This new construction made it impossible to develop a maintenance of traffic plan for the bridge work that was safe and in compliance with Florida Department of Transportation Standards and that would keep the road open in both directions. The contractor, Ranger Construction Industries, Inc., has proposed compensation for 68 days and \$87,993.96 for maintenance of temporary traffic control at the LWDD E-3 canal, and the required detour to maintain traffic in the eastbound direction and close the westbound direction for approximately six weeks.



Dear Ellis,

Pursuant to correspondence sent on November 27, 2006 were we notified Palm Beach County of our intention to claim for cost and time delays caused by the impossibility to develop a MOT plan for the Bridge work that was both safe and compliant with FDOT standards; we are presenting a Change Order proposal that will cover Ranger Construction additional cost incurred for this unforescen circumstance.

I would like to begin by giving you a chronological explanation of events prior to the MOT plan approval process which in time was the main cause of the delay.

We started by verbally notifying Palm Beach County several times of the problems our consultant engineer encountered with the application of any feasible MOT plan. There were dimensions shown in the plans that were not verifiable in the field and after the project was first designed by Mock Roos in 1993, two houses had been constructed near the bridge with their correspondent driveways rendering the proposed MOT plan inapplicable.

On October 26, 2006 we met in the field with Ed McClane and Bob Gunnell to discuss the different problems that needed to be addressed. To follow up, our consultant wrote a letter on November 14, 2006 explaining all discrepancies, contradictions, and public safety flaws of any MOT that was to be applied if we were to keep traffic on the outside lanes of the bridge.

Our Bridge subcontractor Drawdy Construction had to move out of the project in November 6, 2006 due to the MOT plan not been in place and ready to be applied.

On November 29, 2006 we met with Palm Beach County representatives to discuss the comments made by R.F. Cabrera and Associates on the November 14 missive.

In correspondence sent on December 1, 2006 Palm Beach County asked Ranger Construction to provide cost proposals for 3 different scenarios, the first one was to close westbound traffic and provide only easibound traffic; the second one was to keep traffic on both directions using only the south lane of the bridge flagging to alternate traffic; the third one was to close completely the bridge until the work was completed. After in depth revision we determined that the third option was the only one applicable to the existing conditions, and asked Palm Beach County to approve said option but they rejected that option.

Several weeks passed and further discussion over the different options resulted in Palm Beach County and Ranger Construction agreeing on the option of closing the westbound lane at the bridge and keep traffic on the eastbound lane. An MOT plan showing this option was submitted on January 23, 2007, returned for revisions by PBC on January 30, 2007 and resubmitted on February 7, 2007. This last submittal was approved as noted on February 12, 2007.

In order to get this project moving, we are requesting a prompt approval of the attached Change Order, in which we have included additional days to complete the project, as well as the additional costs Ranger Construction has and will incur in relation to this issue.

Since we can still use 47 days of the contract time, we are requesting 68 additional contract days out of the 115 that will take to finish the bridge. To do the calculation on the days for the Change Order we assumed it was going to take Palm Beach County up to February 27, 2007 to approve it. At this point we are not including any financial impacts that this delay had on Drawdy Construction but, if this issue is postponed any further we may seek additional compensation for said matter.

Please rest assured that it is Ranger Construction's main target to finish this work with the less additional time at the lowest cost to Palm Beach County.
