I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Contract with MPA Architects, Inc., to provide architectural services on a continuing contract basis.

Summary: The purpose of this contract is to have a consultant pre-selected and under contract to provide architectural services for capital improvement projects generally with a construction value less than \$3,000,000. Consultant fees will be negotiated on an individual basis for the identified projects. This contract will be for two (2) years with two (2) one year renewal options. This contract includes a goal of 15% which can be met through the use of either M/WBE or SBE firms. MPA Architects, Inc., has committed to a 80% goal. (Capital Improvements Division) Countywide (JM)

Background and Justification: Selection was performed under Board adopted procedures pursuant to the Consultant Competitive Negotiations Act (CCNA) and Florida Statute 287.055, on December 6, 2006. Three firms were selected for these services. Work will be authorized through individual task agreements when they are required during the term of this contract.
