#### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Change Order No. 2 to the Contract with the Poole and Kent Company, Inc. (R2005-1928) for the Lake Region Water Treatment Plant Project (LRWTP) increasing the contract price by \$250,728.

**Summary:** On September 27, 2005, the Board approved a contract with the Poole & Kent Company, Inc. in the amount of \$19,727,000 for construction of the LRWTP (R2005-1928). This Change Order authorizes the Contractor to provide underground fuel storage tanks in lieu of aboveground tanks. Change Order No. 2 (\$250,728) results in a net increase of \$129,836 to the project. Total change orders to date, excluding the \$7,549,033.78 sales tax recovery program change order and this change order, equal zero. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance is 15.00% overall. This change order includes zero SBE participation. The contractor's cumulative SBE participation, including this change order, is 15.92% overall.

Background and Justification: On September 27, 2005, the Board approved a contract with the Poole & Kent Company, Inc. in the amount of \$19,727,000 for construction of the LRWTP (R2005-1928). On October 18, 2005, the Board approved Change Order No. 1 in the deductive amount of \$7,549,033.78, deleting materials and equipment for the purpose of sales tax recovery (R2005-2070) and issuing seventeen Purchase Orders resulting in a tax savings of \$412,962.63. Following Hurricane Wilma in October 2005, the Palm Beach County Facilities Development and Operations determined that underground fuel storage tanks offer greater operational flexibility than aboveground storage tanks. Change Order No. 2 authorizes the Contractor to furnish and install underground storage tanks for an additional cost of \$129,836. The County has agreed to cancel Purchase Order No. 03-169-05 issued to Phoenix Products for the aboveground storage tanks and credit \$120,892 back to the Contractor to purchase the underground tanks.

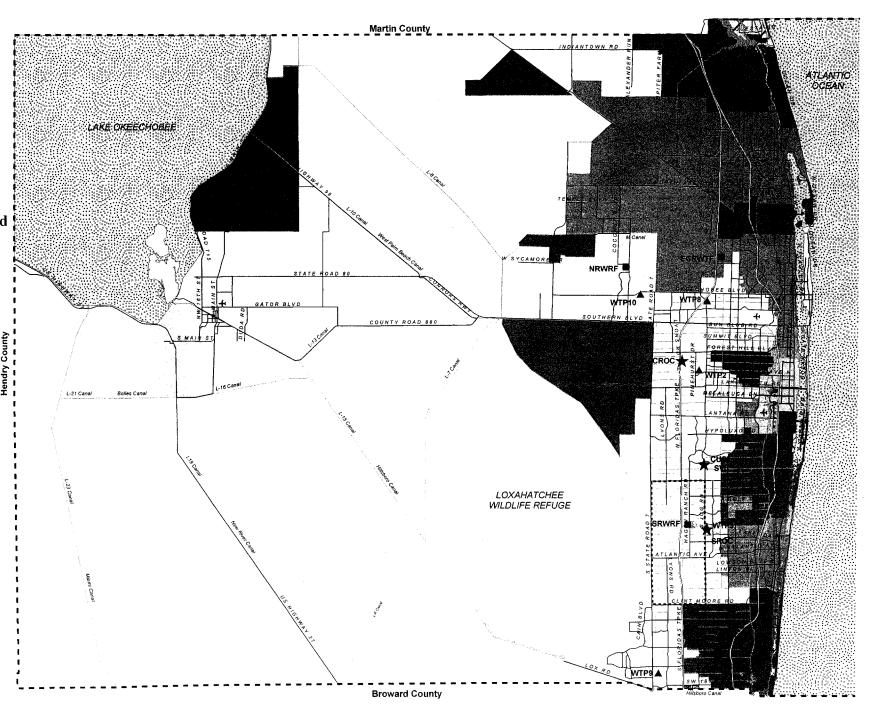

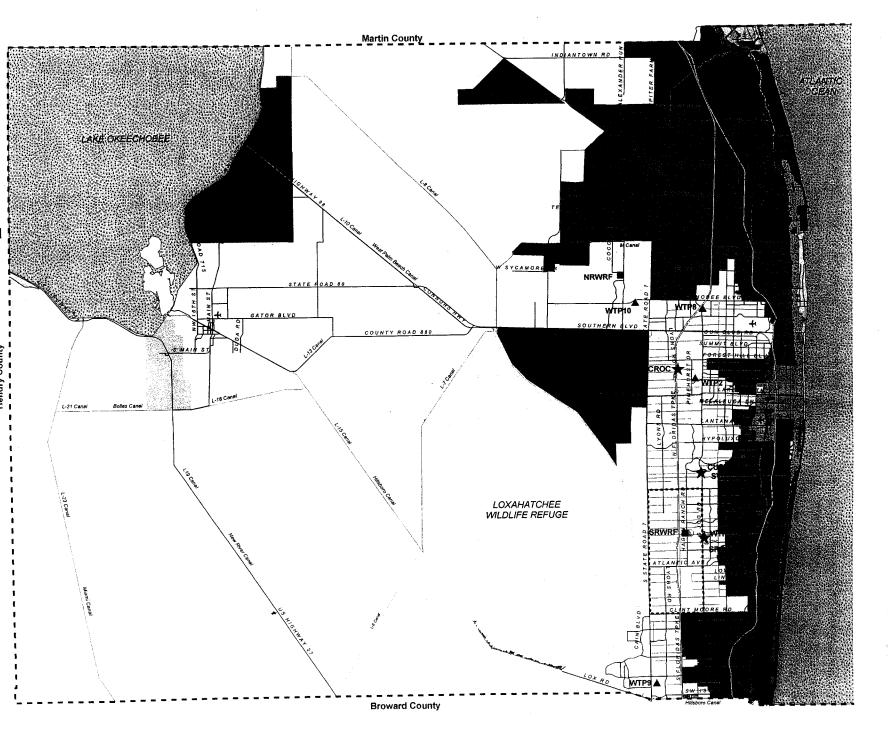

Enclosed please find a cost breakdown to furnish and install two (2) 12,000 gallon double wall underground fuel storage tanks. This quotation replaces the previous quotation dated April 7, 2006. Scope of this proposal is in accordance with RFP#3A (see clarification 5, below). The total lump sum cost of this change amounts to \$250,728.00.

The following clarifications apply:

- 1. This quote is valid for fourteen (14) days, after which it will be re-quoted only upon written request.
- 2. This lump sum proposal is based solely upon direct cost elements, such as labor, material, equipment and normal workmanship and does not include any amount for changes in the sequence of work, delays, disruption, rescheduling, extended overhead, acceleration and impact costs of any type. The Poole and Kent Company reserves the right to submit costs for any and all the aforementioned, as well as related items of costs, including the cumulative impact of all in the aggregate, prior to final job close-out.
- 3. Poole and Kent reserves the right to submit for additional supplemental costs as described in the General Conditions of the Contract Documents when the full impact of this change is realized.
- 4. This proposal excludes any direct and indirect costs resulting from unforeseen work not specifically mentioned herein.

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- 5. The costs of any and all permit fees or permit drawings are specifically not included in the cost of this proposal. Should any permit fees be required, they will be submitted to the owner under a separate cover.
- 6. RFP#3A states (2) 24,000 gallon underground fuel tanks; however, this proposal is for two (2) 12,000 gallon underground fuel tanks per your verbal request for this revision.
- 7. Pricing is based on the layout shown on RFP#3 and does not include costs for the relocation of utilities to accommodate a different layout.
- 8. Tank pricing is based on the submittal data furnished to Palm Beach County on September 26, 2006. Requests for additional accessories may result in added cost.

This change has impacted construction to date with regard to installation of the tanks and surrounding underground utilities. Please issue a lump sum change order in the amount quoted as soon as possible to minimize any further impacts to this project.
