I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a Budget Transfer of \$353,900 in the South Lox SI Wetland Restoration Fund from Reserves to the South Loxahatchee Slough Wetland Restoration project (SLSRP).

Summary: The approximate 780-acre SLSRP area is part of the County's Loxahatchee Slough Natural Area. A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was approved by the Board on July 23, 2002 (R2002-1198). The MOU defines the process by which the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers, Jacksonville District (USACOE) and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) will direct wetland mitigation dollars to the County to help pay for the restoration, enhancement, and long-term management and maintenance of County-owned lands within the SLSRP area. This budget transfer will provide \$353,900 from reserves to the South Loxahatchee Slough Wetland Restoration project. These funds are needed for the restoration, enhancement and long-term management and monitoring activities identified within the SLSRP as identified in the MOU. Countywide (SF)

Background and Justification: The SLSRP and MOU were developed out of the joint desire of the USACOE, FDEP, and County to provide an environmentally-sound, affordable wetland mitigation alternative, which would allow for the development of single-family wetland lots in Jupiter Farms and Palm Beach Country Estates. Agency review of the remaining wetlands in the service area indicated that a vast majority of the wetlands were of very poor quality - having been adversely impacted by invasive exotic vegetation and past drainage practices. Because most of the single-family lots within the service area average 1.25 acres in size, it was not feasible to require on-site mitigation for wetland impacts. The SLSRP was identified as the initial offsite mitigation area for single-family development within Jupiter Farms and Palm Beach Country Estates because of its proximity to the service area; its public ownership; and, the County's commitment to the restoration, enhancement, and long-term management and maintenance of the native habitats within the project site regardless of whether mitigation dollars were received.
