### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Renewal of the Excess Automobile Liability Insurance Policy from State National Insurance Company, purchased through the County's contracted broker, Arthur J. Gallagher & Co., under Contract No. 05-102/LJ, in the amount of \$340,000 for the operation of Palm Tran, Inc's bus fleet for the period April 1, 2007 through April 1, 2008.

Summary: This policy from State National Insurance Company provides \$2,000,000 of coverage excess of a \$100,000 per claimant/\$200,000 per occurrence self-insured retention that is provided by the Self-Insured Retention Plan. The renewal premium is \$340,000, an increase of 9%. This premium is not subject to adjustment for changes in the size of the fleet during the policy period. Countywide (TF/DR)

Background and Justification: Effective April 1, 2002, upon the recommendation of staff with the approval of the Board, the liability exposure of the Palm Tran bus fleet was incorporated into the County's Self-Insured Retention Plan and an Excess Automobile Liability Insurance Policy with limits of \$2,000,000 was purchased. Marketing of coverage was handled by the County's contracted insurance broker Arthur J. Gallagher & Co. The renewal premium for the upcoming policy period \$340,000, an increase of 9% over the expiring premium of \$311,100. The increase is . in premium is due to an increase in the size of the active fleet from 136 to 148 buses plus the addition of a state mandated 1% Florida Hurricane Catastrophe Fund Emergency Assessment. Premium is payable 60% due April 1, 2007, and balance due October 1, 2007.
