### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title:** Staff recommends motion to: A) adopt a Resolution authorizing the Director of Parks and Recreation, as the Project Manager, to apply for a Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, Florida Boating Improvement Program Grant, for funding in the amount of \$500,000 for Moroso Park boating improvement project; and B) authorize the County Administrator or his designee, to execute and administer the grant application on behalf of Palm Beach County.

**Summary:** The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWCC) offers grants to local governments through its Florida Boating Improvement Program for public recreation projects directly related to the waterways. The grant application requests up to \$500,000 from the FWCC, Florida Boating Improvement Program for development and construction costs related to Moroso Park. The grant application must be submitted to the FWCC by April 27, 2007. The grant application requires a resolution authorizing the Project Manager to apply for and administer the grant on behalf of the applicant. The \$500,000 FBIP grant will be matched with \$500,000 from the 2004 \$50 Million Waterfront Access and Preservation General Obligation Bond referendum. <u>District 7</u> (AH)

Background and Justification: Moroso Park is a proposed Intracoastal Waterway access facility which is located in Riviera Beach, Florida. The current estimated construction cost of this boating park is approximately \$3.5 million, and includes 72 car/boat trailer parking spaces, 3 launching ramp lanes, 280 linear feet of staging docks within a boat basin, a restroom building and a viewing pavilion located on the Intracoastal Waterway. The project also includes site lighting, landscaping and related infrastructure. This proposed boating park will provide much needed access to nearby Peanut Island and the Palm Beach Inlet. Construction is scheduled to begin in September 2007 and be complete by December 2008. Due to the park's close proximity to the Palm Beach Inlet and the high demand by boaters, additional car/trailer parking spaces and related facilities are needed in this area. Expansion of boat/trailer parking in proximity to four County inlets is a high priority, and was identified in the Palm Beach County, *Public Boating Needs Assessment Study*, 2002.
