I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: the revised Management Plan for the Delray Oaks Natural Area.

Summary: The Delray Oaks Natural Area Management Plan was originally approved by the Board on June 17, 1997. The Management Plan was revised in 2006-2007 to include additional information regarding the history of the site and its biological resources, a chronology of significant events and activities occurring since the County's acquisition, improvements in management techniques, and other new information. The County continues to manage the natural area with the assistance of the City of Delray Beach. <u>District 4</u> (SF)

Background and Justification: The Palm Beach County Natural Areas Management Advisory Committee (NAMAC) reviews the management plans prepared by County staff for each natural area managed by the County and recommends approval of the plan by the Board of County Commissioners. The goal is to review each approved plan every five (5) years after the initial management plan is approved and every ten (10) years thereafter. Revision of this management plan was delayed due to staff shortage and higher priority projects. Each management plan should be revised as necessary on the basis of new information, research data, improvements in management techniques, or other relevant factors. NAMAC has reviewed the revised Management Plan for the Delray Oaks Natural Area and received public comments on the Management Plan at several of its meetings during 2006. NAMAC recommended approval of the revised Management Plan at its February 16, 2007 meeting. Capital improvements for site development (fencing, signage, trails, management roads/firebreaks, initial exotic vegetation removal, and public use facilities) have been completed. Annual maintenance and operation costs, including biological monitoring, on-going exotic vegetation treatment, and repair and replacement of facilities, as needed, are estimated to be \$72,307. The County will be responsible for \$62,707 of these costs. The remaining \$9,600 will be provided in contributed services by the City of Delray Beach, as a management partner with the County. The next scheduled review of the Management Plan will be in 2017.
