I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: original executed Request for Funding Form for School Board Recreation Assistance Program (RAP) project for Cypress Trails Elementary School, in an amount not-to-exceed \$4,000 for the Physical Fitness through the Arts Program.


Summary: This fully executed Request for Funding Form is for School Board RAP allocations made in accordance with the Interlocal Agreement for the funding of RAP Projects (R2003-1747) approved by the Board on October 21, 2003. District 6 (AH)

Background and Justification: The Interlocal Agreement for the Funding of RAP Projects (R2003-1747) was adopted by the Board to streamline the RAP process. It establishes terms and conditions for all School Board RAP capital and operational projects up to a set amount of \$100,000 and approves the use of the Request for Funding Form for School Board capital and operational projects to provide necessary project information for establishing eligibility of projects and setting forth project descriptions, time frames, and budgets. The Agreement also delegates signature of these forms and amendments to designated School District and County staff. Fully executed originals of the Request for Funding Forms and any subsequent amendments are presented to the Board as a receive and file agenda item to keep the Board apprised of all approved County RAP allocations to the School Board, and to provide for proper recording and budgeting of the Request for Funding Forms and subsequent amendments.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Objective 1 - Participants in grades K-5 will increase their physical fitness levels by 20%.
Activity for Objective 1 - Students will enroll in weekly after school activities such as Double Dutch jump rope teams and walking clubs.
Objective 2 - Participants will extend their critical thinking, vocabulary and enhance their knowledge of various literary genres.
Activity for Objective 2 - Participants will enroll in book club, chess club, drama club and small group tutorials.

PUBLIC PURPOSE: 1. To provide meaningful school and physical activity as an alternative to video games and television. It will help develop physically fit citizens who will develop life long positive attitudes towards healthy lifestyles.

RECREATIONAL OR CULTURAL ARTS COMPONENT: 1. Students will increase their physical fitness by participation in marathons, jump rope and double dutch teams. Students will increase their critical thinking by participating in chess club. The cultural arts component is that students will increase their knowledge of various literary genres through drama presentation and book club.

PROJECT ELEMENTS/PROJECT BUDGET:

Games/Equipment, playbooks, costumes, snacks, paper goods, books for book club, stipends for activities and other miscellaneous expenditures.
