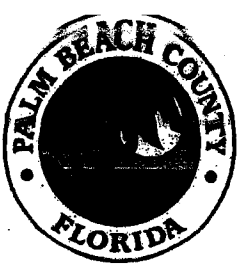

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT WITH KEEP PALM BEACH COUNTY BEAUTIFUL, INC., FOR GENERAL OPERATING EXPENSES

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2007, by and between KEEP PALM BEACH COUNTY BEAUTIFUL, INC., a not-for-profit corporation of the State of Florida, hereinafter "KPBCB", and PALM BEACH COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter "COUNTY".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, KPBCB promotes, facilitates, and reviews beautification grants , as well as promoting various organized clean up programs, hereinafter "PROGRAMS"; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY believes that these efforts by KPBCB serve a public purpose by enhancing the beautification of thoroughfare roadways, as well as other public areas, and wishes to support KPBCB's efforts to do so by providing reimbursement funding for documented costs for such activities, in an amount not to exceed TEN THOUSAND AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$10,000.00); and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises, and agreements herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are true, correct and are incorporated herein.**
- 2. COUNTY agrees to provide to KPBCB reimbursement funding in an amount not to exceed TEN THOUSAND AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$10,000.00) for KPBCB's costs related to PROGRAMS.**
- 3. COUNTY agrees to reimburse KPBCB up to the amount established in paragraph 2 for costs associated with PROGRAMS, upon KPBCB's submission of acceptable documentation needed to substantiate such costs for the PROGRAMS. COUNTY will use its best efforts to provide said funds to KPBCB on a reimbursement basis within forty-five (45) days of receipt of all information required In Paragraph 5, below.**
- 4. COUNTY's obligation is limited to its payment obligation as set forth in Paragraph 2, and COUNTY shall have no obligation to any other person or entity.**

1 **5. KPBCB shall furnish the Manager, Streetscape Section, of COUNTY's**
2 **Department of Engineering and Public Works with a request for payment supported**
3 **by paid invoices, checks, payroll records, or such other documentation which is**
4 **acceptable in form and detail to the COUNTY to provide for verification that the**
5 **services and/or materials have been performed and/or received by KPBCB.**

6 **6. KPBCB shall maintain adequate records to justify all charges,**
7 **expenses, and costs pertaining to PROGRAMS for at least three (3) years after**
8 **COUNTY's final reimbursement. COUNTY shall have access to all books, records**
9 **and documents as required in this Section for the purpose of inspection or audit**
10 **during normal business hours.**

11 **7. All invoices from KPBCB shall be submitted to COUNTY no later than**
12 **September 30, 2008, and COUNTY shall have no obligation to KPBCB or any other**
13 **entity or person for any cost incurred thereafter unless the time for completion is**
14 **extended by modification of this Agreement as provided herein.**

15 **8. KPBCB recognizes that it is an independent contractor, and not an**
16 **agent or servant of COUNTY or its Board of County Commissioners. In the event a**
17 **claim or lawsuit is brought against COUNTY, its officers, employees, servants or**
18 **agents, relating to any item which is the responsibility of KPBCB, KPBCB hereby**
19 **agrees to indemnify, save and hold harmless COUNTY, its officers, employees,**
20 **servants or agents, and to defend said persons from any such claims, liabilities,**
21 **causes of action and judgments of any type whatsoever arising out of or relating to**
22 **the performance by KPBCB as may relate to this Agreement. KPBCB agrees to pay**
23 **all costs, attorney's fees and expenses incurred by COUNTY, its officers, employees,**
24 **servants or agents in connection with such claims, liabilities or suits except as may**
25 **be incurred due to the negligence of COUNTY.**

26 **9. As provided in F.S. 287.132-133, by entering into this Agreement or**
27 **performing any work in furtherance hereof, KPBCB certifies that its affiliates,**
28 **suppliers, sub-contractors, and consultants who perform work hereunder, have not**
29 **been placed on the convicted vendor list maintained by the State of Florida**

1 Department of Management Services within 36 months immediately preceding the
2 date hereof. This notice is required by F.S. 287.133(3)(a).

3 10. KPBCB's termination of this AGREEMENT shall result all obligations of
4 COUNTY for funding contemplated herein to be canceled.

5 11. COUNTY and KPBCB agree that no person shall, on the grounds of
6 race, color, national origin, sexual orientation, religion or creed, sex, age, or
7 handicap be discriminated against in performance of the Agreement.

8 12. In the event that any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or provision
9 hereof is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not
10 affect the remaining portions of this Agreement and the same shall remain in full
11 force and effect.

12 13. All notices required to be given under this Agreement shall be in
13 writing, and deemed sufficient to each party when sent by United States Mail,
14 postage prepaid, to the following:

25 14. This Agreement shall be construed and governed by the laws of the
26 State of Florida. Any and all legal action necessary to enforce this Agreement shall
27 be held in Palm Beach County. No remedy herein conferred upon any party is
28 intended to be exclusive of any other remedy, and each and every other remedy shall
29 be cumulative and shall be in addition to every other remedy given hereunder or now
30 or hereafter existing at law or in equity or by statute or otherwise. No single or
31 partial exercise by any party of any right, power, or remedy shall preclude any other
32 or further exercise thereof.

1 **15. Any costs or expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees)**
2 **associated with the enforcement of the terms and conditions of this Agreement**
3 **shall be borne by the respective parties; provided, however, that this clause pertains**
4 **only to the parties to the Agreement.**

5 **16. Except as expressly permitted herein to the contrary, no modification,**
6 **amendment, or alteration in the terms or conditions contained herein shall be**
7 **effective unless contained in a written document executed with the same formality**
8 **and equality of dignity herewith.**

9 **17. The parties to this Agreement shall not be deemed to assume any**
10 **liability for the negligent or wrongful acts, or omissions of the other party (or**
11 **parties). Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a waiver by COUNTY, by**
12 **any of the parties, of the liability limits established in Section 768.28, Florida**
13 **Statutes.**

14 **18. KPBCB shall promptly notify COUNTY of any lawsuit-related complaint,**
15 **or cause of action threatened or commenced against it which arises out of or**
16 **relates, in any manner, to the performance of this Agreement.**

17 **19. The parties expressly covenant and agree that in the event any of the**
18 **parties is in default of its obligations under this Agreement, the parties not in default**
19 **shall provide to the defaulting party thirty (30) days written notice before exercising**
20 **any of their rights.**

21 **20. The preparation of this Agreement has been a joint effort of the parties,**
22 **and the resulting document shall not, solely as a matter of judicial constraint, be**
23 **construed more severely against one of the parties than the other.**

24 **21. This Agreement represents the entire understanding among the parties,**
25 **and supersedes all other negotiations, representations, or agreements, either written**
26 **or oral, relating to this Agreement.**

27 **22. A copy of this Agreement shall be filed with the Clerk of the Circuit**
28 **Court in and for Palm Beach County, Florida.**
