I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: A contract with Hypower, Inc. in the amount of \$1,807,455 for the Roadway, Parking and Terminal Signage Replacement/Improvement Plan Project at Palm Beach International Airport (PBIA) with a modification to the insurance requirements deleting Builders Risk Insurance and replacing it with an Installation Floater.

Summary: This project was advertised utilizing the competitive bid process. On February 13, 2007 two bids were received for the Roadway, Parking and Terminal Signage Replacement/Improvement Plan Project at PBIA. Hypower, Inc. has been identified as a responsible/responsive bidder in the amount of \$1,807,455 which includes the base bid and alternates 2, 3 and 4. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Goal for this project was established at 15.00%. Hypower, Inc. bid contained 68.09% SBE participation. Risk Management's review determined that the insurance requirements should include an Installation Floater in lieu of the Builders Risk Insurance. There is no difference in cost to the contract. **Countywide (JCM)**

Background and Justification: As part of the BCC approved Airport Master Plan, the Department of Airports has executed the competitive bidding process for the Roadway, Parking and Terminal Signage Replacement/Improvement Plan Project at PBIA. The project includes the comprehensive replacement of informational airport signage in areas accessible to the public. The signage to be replaced includes the terminal areas, the existing short term parking garage and a limited number of roadway signs. It does not include signs on the Air Operations Area (AOA). This project is being constructed utilizing Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) Funds.

The prices named in the Bid are for the completed work, and include the furnishing of all materials and all labor, tools, and appliances and all expense, direct or indirect, connected with the proper execution of the work and of maintaining the same until it is accepted by the Board of County Commissioners.

Time is of the essence. The Contractor shall commence the work to be performed under this Contract on the date set by the Owner in the written notice to proceed, continue the work with due diligence and shall complete the entire work per Attachment No. 2 to the Bid Form. Further, in the event interim milestone completion dates are established in Attachment No. 2 of the Bid Form for separable portions of the work, the Contractor agrees to complete said separable portions of the work in accordance with said milestone dates.

In case of failure on the part of the Contractor to complete the work within the time(s) specified in the Contract, or within such additional time(s) as may be granted by formal action of the Board of County Commissioners or fails to prosecute the work, or any separable part thereof, with such diligence as will insure its completion within the time(s) specified in the Contract or any extensions thereof, Owner will suffer damage, the amount of which is difficult, if not impossible to ascertain. Therefore, the Contractor shall pay to the Owner, as liquidated damages, the amounts indicated in the Milestone and Damages Data (Attachment #2 of the Bid Form) for each calendar day of delay that actual completion extends beyond the time limits specified in said Attachment until such reasonable time as may be required for final completion of work. In no way shall costs for liquidated damages be construed as a penalty on the Contractor.

Liquidated damages due to the Owner may be deducted from payments due to the Contractor, or may be collected from the Contractor or its surety or sureties. These provisions for liquidated damages shall not prevent the Owner, in case of the Contractor's default, from terminating the Contractor's right to proceed as provided in the *General Conditions*.

As provided in F.S. 287.132-133, by entering into this contract or performing any work in furtherance hereof, the contractor certifies that it, its affiliates, suppliers, subcontractors and consultants who will perform hereunder, have not been placed on the Convicted Vendor List maintained by the State of Florida Department of Management Services within the 36 months immediately preceding the date hereof. This notice is required by F.S. 287.133 (3) (a).

CH2M HILL and our team members: Apple Design Incorporated (ADI), Hillers Electrical Engineering, and the Sun Group conducted a technical review of the two (2) bid proposals for the above referenced project. The bid proposals were submitted by Hypower, Inc. and Architectural Graphics Incorporated (AGI). Hypower presented the lower bid at \$1,597,745.00 for the base and \$2,586,440.00 for the base with the additive alternates. AGI presented bids of \$3,555,868.78 for the base and \$4,213,912.52 for the base with additive alternates.

Compared to the engineer's estimate, Hypower's base bid is 11% lower than the base bid estimate and 10% higher than the base bid with additive alternates. Hypower's bid falls within an acceptable range of the engineer's estimate as defined by general estimating practices. AGI's bids were 99% higher and 79% higher than the engineer's estimate respectively. Relative to each other, AGI's base bid is 55% higher than Hypower's base bid and 39% higher than the base bid with additive alternates. A tabular comparison of the bids is attached.

The DOA expressed concern with the low number of bidders. During the bid phase, the project team made every reasonable effort to generate interest in the project. However, we do not recommend re-bidding the project because in our professional opinion, the possibility of receiving better numbers for this project is minimal.

Both bidders appear to be qualified and provided the general technical elements of the project with no exceptions to the Bid Documents. On March 5, 2007, members of the project design team conducted an interview with Hypower and their subcontractor, Baron Signs. It is our professional opinion that Hypower and Baron possess an acceptable level of understanding of the technical and construction requirements for the project.

The Department of Airports (DOA) is advised to determine which of the additive alternates it wishes to execute with the base bid, if any. It is the opinion of the project team that Additive Alternates 2, 3, and 4 should be included in the project at a minimum. By exercising the base bid and recommended additive alternates, the DOA can complete all parts of the master signage plan affecting the terminal and parking areas.

We reviewed and tabulated the required Palm Beach County documents for the bid and can discern no significant errors or omissions on the part of either bidder. Based on our analysis, we recommend that Hypower Inc. be awarded the project both as the low bidder and as technically qualified to perform the scope of work as defined in the bid documents, subject to county legal and DBE review. 


