I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Change Order No. 3 to the Contract with R.J. Sullivan, Corp. (R2006-0780) for the Water Treatment Plant No. 8 Expansion Project increasing the contract price by \$154,251.96 and providing a seventy (70) day time extension.

Summary: Change Order No. 3 authorizes the Contractor to perform various civil, mechanical, and electrical improvements for this project; resolve conflicts with the proposed new facilities; and provides the Contractor with additional time (70 days) to accomplish the additional work. The enhancements include safety improvements at the existing sodium hypochlorite generator building, motorized valves in the filter building, re-painting of the containment walls for the existing brine and sodium hypochlorite storage tanks (as recommended by Palm Beach County Environmental Resource Management Department), and concrete encasement of the transfer pump discharge header. Total change orders to date, excluding the \$1,712,386.46 sales tax recovery program change order, equal \$299,570.36 (1.61% increase). The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance is 15.0% overall. This change order includes zero overall SBE participation. The contractor's cumulative SBE participation, including this change order, is 27.31% overall.

Background and Justification: The County has been expanding its utility infrastructure to provide water and wastewater service to the Northern Region including the Beeline Community Development District, Seminole Improvement District and Seacoast Utility Authority. The Water Treatment Plant No. 8 Expansion will provide an additional 10 million gallons per day of potable water to accommodate the utility's expansion. On May 2, 2006, the Board approved the construction contract with R.J. Sullivan Corp. (R2006-0780). This change order will authorize system enhancements, the relocation of existing facilities which are in conflict with the proposed plant expansion and safety improvements to the existing sodium hypochlorite generation system for disinfection.

SCOPE OF WORK

- 3.1 <u>F&I 22 ½ Bend on New 30-inch Water Main to 5 Million Gallon Storage Tank</u> (Differing Site Conditions) The alignment of the new water main is being revised to avoid a conflict with trees that are designated to be preserved as part of the site plan approval for this project.
- 3.2 <u>Install Concrete Casing Around Transfer Pump Discharge Header</u> (Owner Initiated) This is an enhancement which is designed to provide greater protection to the discharge header to reduce the possibility of damage or leaks in the transfer pump piping.
- 3.3 <u>F&I Safety Modifications to the Existing Sodium Hypochlorite Generation System</u> (Owner Initiated) Analysis of a recent failure of the existing system resulted in a design to modify piping, valving and to install a new venting system.
- 3.4 <u>F&I Approved Alternative Roofing System For Filter Building</u> (Owner Initiated) Review by the County and our consultant of an alternative roofing system proposed by the contractor resulted in an equal roofing system for a lower cost. The saving will result in a credit to the County.
- 3.5 <u>F&I Five Motorized Valves In Filter Venturi Tubes</u> (Owner Initiated) This is a system enhancement which will give the plant operators improved filter system control and ease of filter operation.
- 3.6 Paint the Walls and Floor of the Existing Brine and Sodium Hypochlorite Containment Areas (Request by Another Agency). A recent plant inspection by ERM resulted in direction to the plant superintendent to paint the floor and walls of the existing brine and sodium hypochlorite tank containment areas.
- 3.7 <u>F&I Piping and Fittings to Avoid Conflict with Existing Piping and Electrical Ductbanks</u> (Differing Site Conditions) To avoid conflicts between existing and proposed piping and ductbanks, additional pipe and fittings are necessary. The location of these existing facilities were unknown and not shown on the drawings or shown incorrectly.
- 3.8 <u>F&I Bell Restraints on an Existing 8-Inch Plant Water Main (Differing Site Conditions)</u> The existing 8-inch plant water main had to be restrained in order to accomplish a crossing with a proposed 24-inch main from the Anionic Resin Exchange System.
- 3.9 <u>F&I Six 30-Inch Fittings on New Filter Drain Line</u> (Errors/Omissions in Design) A misalignment between the existing and proposed Filter drain lines requires six 30-inch fittings in order to make the connection between the existing and proposed drain line.
- 3.10 <u>F&I Four 18-Inch Fittings on New Filter Backwash Line</u> (Errors/Omissions in Design) A misalignment between the existing and proposed Filter Backwash lines requires four 18-inch fittings in order to make the connection between the existing and proposed backwash lines.
