PREPARE PERMIT APPLICATIONS, PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR COASTAL AND MARINE PROJECTS. PREPARE APPLICATIONS FOR GRANTS. SERVE AS AN EXPERT WITNESS. PROVIDE ASSISTANCE WITH BIDDING CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS AND INSPECTION OF CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.**

*Pursuant to the Palm Beach County Code, Section 2-80-21 – 2-80-34, the County will provide contracting opportunities for SBEs and also desires to provide contracting opportunities for M/WBEs in the area of professional services pursuant to Section 287.055, Florida Statutes, as amended, known as the “Consultant’s Competitive Negotiation Act” (CCNA).*

*Palm Beach County’s minimum SBE goal is 15%.*
