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2	A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
3	LOXAHATCHEE GROVES, FLORIDA, REQUESTING THE
4	REMOVAL OF THAT PORTION OF OKEECHOBEE
5	BOULEVARD LOCATED EAST OF FOLSOM ROAD TO WEST
6	OF "E" ROAD FROM THE COUNTY'S FIVE YEAR ROAD
7	PROGRAM; DIRECTING TOWN CLERK TO TRANSMIT THE
8	RESOLUTION TO THE APPROPRIATE COUNTY OFFICIALS;
9	PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR
10	SEVERABILITY: PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, the Town of Loxahatchee Groves (hereinafter referred to as the "Town") is a recently-incorporated contiguous rural community in Palm Beach County experiencing a negative impact from the urbanization of certain surrounding areas; and

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WHEREAS, Palm Beach County's ("County") five-year road program currently provides for the widening of Okeechobee Boulevard from west of "E" Road to east of Folsom Road sometime in either fiscal year 2009 or fiscal year 2010; and

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WHEREAS, the County is also planning to widen Seminole Pratt Whitney Road during the 2007-2009 fiscal years; and

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WHEREAS, the Town anticipates that the widening of Seminole Pratt Whitney Road, as well as the completion of the Southern Boulevard improvements will alleviate traffic conditions on Okeechobee Boulevard; and

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WHEREAS, due to the anticipated impact of the widening of Seminole Pratt Whitney Road on Okcechobee Boulevard, the Town Council finds that it would be appropriate to study the need for widening Okeechobee Boulevard between Folsom Road and "E" Road; and

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WHEREAS, in an effort to preserve the composition and integrity of the Town of Loxahatchee Groves, the Town would specifically request that the County Commission remove the widening of Okeechobee Boulevard from the County's fiveyear plan until such time as the impacts of improvements to Seminole Pratt Whitney Road and Southern Boulevard can be determined; and

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WHEREAS, the Town Council deems it to be in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the Town to remove the widening of Okeechobee Boulevard from west of "E" Road to east of Folsom Road from the Palm Beach County five-year program, and to condition any future widening of Okeechobee Road on the need of such widening following the completion of the improvements to Seminole Pratt Whitney Road and Southern Boulevard as identified in the five-year road program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LOXAHATCHEE GROVES, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are true and correct and hereby ratified and confirmed by the Town Council.

SECTION 2. The Town Council of the TOWN OF LOXAHATCHEE GROVES, Florida hereby recommends and supports the removal of the Okeechobee Boulevard improvements from the Palm Beach County five-year program until such time as the County studies whether the impacts from the improvements associated with the widening of Seminole Pratt Whitney Road and Southern Boulevard alleviate the need for improvements to Okeechobee Boulevard.

SECTION 3. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered eliminated and will in no way affect the validity of the other provisions of this Resolution.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.

SOUTH FLORIDA REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY RESOLUTION NO. 07-04

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING PALM BEACH COUNTY'S TRANSIT ORIENTED DEVELOPMENT ("TOD") CONCURRENCY AMENDMENT TO ITS COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR TOD PROJECTS AND PLANNING AT TRI-RAIL STATIONS IN PALM BEACH COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the South Florida Regional Transportation Authority ("SFRTA") is a body politic and corporate, a public instrumentality and an agency of the State of Florida pursuant to Florida Statutes, Chapter 343; and

WHEREAS, the integration of land use and transportation planning has been shown to increase transit ridership; improve transit efficiency, effectiveness, and safety; enhance transportation mobility; promote sustainable development patterns; and improve the success of transit service; and

WHEREAS, "transit-oriented development," or TOD, is one means by which land use and transportation planning have been successfully integrated in conjunction with passenger transit service in the United States and internationally; and

WHEREAS, supporting and encouraging TOD projects and planning at Tri-Rail stations is a goal of the SFRTA: and

WHEREAS, TOD can be encouraged by supportive policies and regulations in local government plans, including comprehensive land use plans and land development codes; and

WHEREAS, Palm Beach County has recently developed and transmitted an amendment to its Comprehensive Plan to define TOD, identify specific TOD design standards, and establish a lower traffic concurrency level-of-service for TOD projects as defined and specified; and

WHEREAS, the Palm Beach County TOD amendment can become a regulatory incentive to encourage TOD projects and planning at Tri-Rail stations in Palm Beach County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY GOVERNING BOARD OF THE SOUTH FLORIDA REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY:

- Section 1. The recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are incorporated by reference herein.
- Section 2. SFRTA hereby expresses its support for Palm Beach County's Transit Oriented Development ("TOD") Concurrency Amendment to its Comprehensive Plan for TOD Projects and Planning at Tri-Rail Stations in Palm Beach County.

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid or ineffective for any reason, the remainder of this Resolution shall continue in full force and effect, it being expressly hereby found and declared that the remainder of this Resolution would have been adopted despite the invalidity or ineffectiveness of such section, paragraph, clause or provision.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption, and any provisions of any previous resolutions in conflict with the provisions herein are hereby superseded.
