I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: A) Approve a budget amendment for the Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) grant increasing the Sheriff's Grant Fund (1152) in the amount of \$446,308; B) Rescind the action of agenda item 3BB5, R2007-0718 dated May 1, 2007; C) Approve a grant match in the amount of \$185,445 from the State Law Enforcement Trust Fund and; D) Approve a budget transfer in the amount of \$185,445 from the State Law Enforcement Trust Enforcement Trust Fund (1151).

Summary: The Board approved the acceptance of this grant award on April 16, 2002. The purpose for this agenda item is to fully expend the funds. The grant allows for the hiring of ten (10) deputies, increasing the number of deputes working as School Resource Officers (SRO's) in Palm Beach County District Schools. PBSO hired three (3) deputies in FY 2002 and an additional four (4) deputies in FY 2004 and the remaining (3) deputies in FY 2005. Of the \$1,250,000 originally awarded for the grant, \$1,019,137 was expended as of September 30, 2006. The PBSO is requesting the amount of \$13,942 currently in deferred revenue from FY 2006 and the amount of \$216,921 from the final year of funding to fully spend the remaining grant funding. The PBSO intends to use a total of \$185,445 in State LETF funds to provide the required match. Approval of this request will reduce the LETF balance to \$947,878. Countywide (DW)

Background and Justification: The COPS office awards grants for a variety of law enforcement purposes including the hiring of additional officers. In recognition of the need for and benefit of having law enforcement officers in Schools, the COPS office has implemented the "COPS in Schools" program. The program funds the base salary and benefits of newly hired law enforcement officers to be deployed in schools. The grant funding is offered for three (3) years. After the three (3) year grant period, respective grant recipients are required to demonstrate that they have increased the number of law enforcement officers employed by at least the number of officers funded through the grant program.

The PBSO presently has deputies assigned to work in schools. One (1) of the tasks performed by PBSO deputies is teaching a course entitled "Aggressors, Victims and Bystanders." This course helps students learn how to handle conflict and when to contact an adult. Due to the growing student population, the demand for this course and other services provided by PBSO deputies in schools is increasing.

Art C. Johnson PhD., Superintendent of the School Board of Palm Beach County, supports this program and has signed the grant application as the partnering school. All activities conducted by PBSO deputies are performed in cooperation with the School Board Police Department. Both the PBSO and the School Board of Palm Beach County agree that this program will increase the safety of Palm Beach County Schools and is necessary to deter a repeat of the Grunow tragedy.

The Sheriff's Office certifies that the use of State LETF funds is in accordance with F.S. 932.7055.

I. <u>EXECUTIVE BRIEF</u>

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Staff recommends motion to approve: the return of \$13,941.46 of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) in Schools Grant funds to the U.S. Department of Justice.

Summary: On April 16, 2002, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) accepted the COPS in Schools Grant from the U.S. Department of Justice. The BCC approved the budget of \$293,364 for FY06; however, \$307,305.46 was drawn from the available grant funds. As the amount drawn down exceeds the FY06 budgeted amount by \$13,941.46, Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office is requesting the return of the excess grant funds to the U.S. Department of Justice. <u>Countywide</u> (DW)

Background and Justification: Pursuant to County PPM#CW-F-003, the return of these funds requires the approval of the BCC.
