Summary: A Notice of Grant Award from the Department of Health and Human Services Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) was received on May 23, 2007, that conveys an award for the contract period March 1, 2007, through February 29, 2008. Total supplemental funds awarded are \$1,949,450 of which \$44,615 is allocated for Grantee Administration. The grantee, Palm Beach County, is responsible for selecting and contracting with services providers. The HIV Care Council is charged with the sole responsibility of determining service priorities and the allocation of funding the service priorities. The grant award is for the provision of services related to HIV affected clients, such as case management, medical care, and dental care. The agencies listed were selected through the Request For Proposal (RFP) process and have been recommended to receive funding. (Ryan White) <u>Countywide</u> (TKF)

Background and Justification: Under the new Ryan White Treatment Modernization Act of 2006, the Palm Beach County HIV Care Council establishes priority service areas and assigns funding percentages. The grantee, Palm Beach County, is responsible for the Request For Proposal (RFP), selection and contracting with the selected service providers. The RFP process for this grant cycle has been completed and the Department has selected agencies to receive funding in accordance with the service priorities and funding allocations designated by the HIV Care Council.
