I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Work Authorization No. 6 to the Water Utilities Department continuing construction contract with AKA Services, Inc. (R2007-0357) for construction of the Aberdeen Reclaimed Water Pipeline Project in the amount of \$1,776,823.89.

Summary: On March 13, 2007, the Board approved the Water Utilities Department Continuing Construction Contract with AKA Services, Inc. (R2007-0357). This Work Authorization provides for construction of the Aberdeen Reclaimed Water Pipeline Project. The reclaimed water main will be installed along Hagen Ranch Road from Boynton Beach Boulevard to north of Gateway Boulevard and east and west of Hagen Ranch Road connecting to existing pipelines on Boynton Beach Boulevard. This pipeline will provide future reclaimed water service to surrounding communities for landscape irrigation purposes. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance (R2002-0064) is 15.00% overall. The contract with AKA Services, Inc. provides for SBE participation of 15.21% overall. This Authorization includes 15.77% overall participation. The cumulative SBE participation, including this Authorization, is 19.60% overall. (WUD Project No. 06-183)

Background and Justification: The Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department is dedicated to promoting economically and technically feasible technologies for water conservation. One component of this effort is landscape irrigation utilizing reclaimed water from the Southern Region Water Reclamation Facility (SRWRF). This project will allow the Department to expand its reclaimed water distribution system, allowing for additional users to connect to the system. On March 13, 2007, the Board approved the Water Utilities Department Continuing Construction Contract with AKA Services, Inc. (R-2007-0357). Palm Beach County Water Utilities applied for 40% grant funding for this project from South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) as part of the 2008 Alternative Water Supply Program.

Department recently executed two standard reclaimed water agreements with Aberdeen and Palm Isle West (ORB 21838, PG 659) to deliver approximately two (2) million gallons per day of reclaimed water to these communities. Aberdeen Reclaimed Water Pipeline will also enable the department to provide additional one (1) million gallons per day of reclaimed water to Ponte Vecchio and other communities along Hagen Ranch Road.

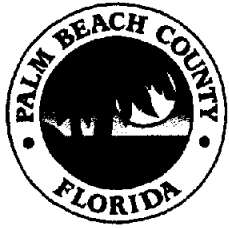

Major Facilities**

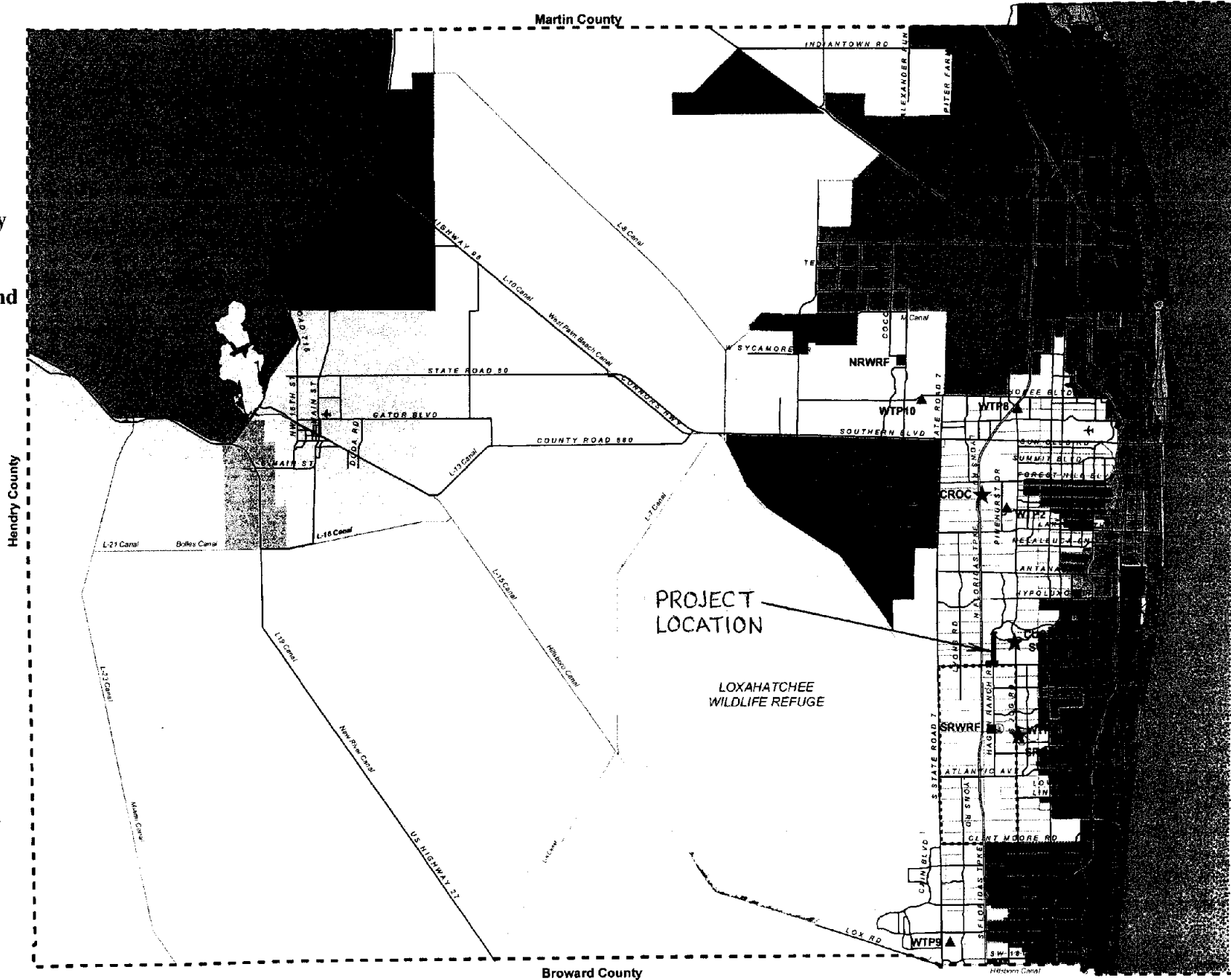

INTRODUCTION

Palm Beach County (County) entered into a Contract for Construction Services date March 13, 2007 (Resolution/Document 2007-0357), by and between Palm Beach County and AKA Services, Inc., for the Construction Services of this Authorization.

This Contract for Construction Services encompasses providing services related to installation of reclaimed water mains on Hagen Ranch Road and Boynton Beach Blvd.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

The Contractor shall provide and install 2116 lineal feet of 12" DIP reclaimed water main, 7590 lineal feet of 16" DIP reclaimed water main, fire hydrants, fittings and appurtenances in the Aberdeen area to provide reclaimed water for irrigation. All water mains and water services shall be constructed in accordance with Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department Minimum Engineering and Construction Standards, as indicated in the construction plans and contract documents.

COMPENSATION

Compensation shall be based on the Contract for Construction Services dated March 13, 2007 (Resolution/Document 2007-0357) as approved by the Board of County Commissioners.

SBE- M/WBE PARTICIPATION

4. Performs the guarantee of all work and materials furnished under the contract for the time specified in the contract, then this bond is void; otherwise it remains in full force.


