I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a settlement in the amount of \$129,850, including attorney's fees, but excluding costs, in the eminent domain action styled <u>Palm Beach County v. Maria Mink, et al.</u>, Case No. 502006CA010149XXXXMB, for business damages as to Southern Gardens Nursery, operated by this business tenant on parcel 103.

Summary: The County has negotiated a business damage settlement in the amount of \$129,850, including attorney's fees, but excluding costs, subject to the approval of the Board of County Commissioners, for business damages to Southern Gardens Nursery being operated on parcel 103. Pursuant to Section 73.015, Florida Statutes (2006), the business tenant made an initial good faith offer in the amount of \$194,266 to settle its business damage claim. Pursuant to the same Statute, the County timely made a counter business damage offer in the amount of \$70,000. At mediation the County entered in to a proposed business damage settlement in the amount of \$115,000, subject to approval of the Board of County Commissioners. Attorney's fees in the amount of \$14,850 were calculated mathematically pursuant to Florida Iaw, making the total settlement amount, inclusive of attorney's fees, but excluding costs, \$129,850. If this settlement is approved, the County would be required to pay \$129,850 to fully fund this settlement, excluding costs, because in the case of business damages there is no initial deposit made in to the Registry of the Court. <u>District 6</u> (PM)

Background and Justification: The taking of property on parcel 103 negatively impacted the drainage on the subject property, thus negatively effecting the Nursery's ability to maintain its current profit level. As a result, the business tenant, Southern Gardens Nursery, submitted its business damage offer, including costs to cure in the amount of \$194,266. After making significant adjustments to the business owners cost to cure and proposing its own alternate cure, the County was able to reduce the business damages to the nursery and reduce the cost to cure. As a result, at mediation the County entered in to a settlement of \$115,000 for all business damages and cure, subject to the approval of the Board of County Commissioners. (Continued on Page 3)

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Background and Justification (continued):

Attorney's fees calculated pursuant to Florida law are \$14,850. The total proposed settlement, including attorney's fees, but excluding costs, is \$129,850, and was approved by the Engineering Department, the County's business damage expert, and the County's appraiser. Therefore, in order to minimize the County's expose to additional damages and substantial additional costs and attorney's fees, this settlement is recommended and very favorable to the County.

Adams Weaver, Esquire, Post Office Box 3475, West Palm Beach, Florida, 33402-3475.

 Petitioner, Palm Beach County shall also pay attorneys fees calculated mathematically pursuant to Florida law in the amount of Fourteen Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty
Dollars and 00/100 (\$14,850.00) by check made payable to Jones, Foster, Johnston & Stubbs,
P.A., Trust Account and mail same to H. Adams Weaver, Esquire, Post Office Box 3475, West
Palm Beach, Florida, 33402-3475, within thirty (30) days from the date of entry of this Order.

3. The Court shall reserve jurisdiction to award the Respondent's expert fees and

costs pursuant to Florida law.
