I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: A) a unit price Contract with Southeast Drilling Services, Inc. for the Water Utilities Department Wellfield Rehabilitation Program to repair wells over a 24 month term in a cumulative amount not to exceed \$1,672,500; and B) Work Authorization No. 1 to rehabilitate wells at Water Treatment Plants No. 2, 3, 8, 9 and 10 in the amount of \$700,000.

Summary: On September 12, 2007, one (1) bid was received for the Water Utilities Department Wellfield Rehabilitation Program, from Southeast Drilling Services, Inc. in the amount of \$1,672,500. This contract will be used for wellfield rehabilitation to maintain adequate raw water supply to all the Department's water treatment plants. Contract award is for the base contract only, and this contract by itself does not guarantee nor authorize Southeast Drilling Services, Inc. to perform any work. Work will be assigned during the 24 month contract period by formal work authorizations drawn against this continuing contract, with approvals pursuant to PPM CW-F-050. The unit prices contained in this contract will be used in determining the cost of these work authorizations. Supplements to work authorizations for changes that occur during construction will be subject to the change order limits for construction contracts as established under PPM CW-F-050 with each work authorization considered as an individual construction contract. Work Authorization No. 1 provides for rehabilitation of wells at Water Treatment Plants No. 2, 3, 8, 9 and 10 in the amount of \$700,000. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance (R2002-0064) is 15.00% overall. This contract with Southeast Drilling Services, Inc. provides for SBE participation of zero overall. Rehabilitation for large water wells requires special construction services thereby reducing options for SBE participation. Overall SBE participation is zero percent because Southeast Drilling was the only bidder.

(WUD Project No. 07-184 & 08-023) District 2, 5 and 6

Background and justification: Palm Beach County operates five water treatment plants with a total of 97 wells. Potable water wells require periodic rehabilitation to maintain productivity and minimize electrical pumping costs. Using a continuing construction contract for wellfield rehabilitation provides an efficient means to maximize wellfield productivity. Work Authorization No. 1 provides for rehabilitation of 12 wells and for monthly chemical maintenance injections of 20 wells for a one year period at Water Treatment Plants No. 2, 3, 8, 9 and 10 in the amount of \$700,000.





The bid opening for the above referenced project was held on Wednesday, September 12, 2007. A proposal was received from one (1) contractor as follows:

Southeast Drilling Services \$1,672,500.00

The complete Bid Tabulation is attached. The Engineers opinion of probable construction cost was \$1,500,000.00. An evaluation of the low bid is as follows:

- 1. Southeast Drilling Services bid is the sole bidder and is using Amps as a subcontractor. This project team successfully completed the previous Wellfield Rehabilitation Continuing Construction Contract, WUD 06-084.
- 2. Bid security equal to 5% of the total base bid was enclosed with the bid.
- 3. SBE-M/WBE Schedules #1 and 2 were provided with 0.0% participation. Therefore the contractor <u>did</u> meet 15% SBE goals established under the SBE Ordinance. The Office of Small Business Assistance Compliance Review is attached stating the Contractor did not meet the SBE goal.
- 4. The contractor and sub-contractors have current well driller's licenses.

The overall experience, qualifications, resources and references of the low bidder were carefully considered when evaluating the bids. Contract award is recommended to the lowest responsive bidder, Southeast Drilling Services in the amount not to exceed \$1,672,500.00 subject to formal approval by the Board of County Commissioners. A copy of this notice has been posted at the bid opening location and will be left there for a minimum of five (5) business days.
