I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

A) Amendment No. 1 to Grant Agreement No. 07PB2 (R2007-0988) with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) for additional cost-sharing in the amount of \$345,255 for a total of up to \$1,378,849 for the Sub-Tropical Storm Andrea Emergency Dune Restoration; and

B) Budget Amendment of \$345,255 in the Beach Improvement Fund to recognize the Amendment revenue in the Emergency Beach Response Program.

Summary: On June 19, 2007, the Board approved FDEP Grant Agreement No. 07PB2 (R2007-0988) for \$1,033,594 in emergency beach funding for Lantana, Singer Island and South Palm Beach. Amendment No. 1 provides additional FDEP funding of up to \$345,255 for dune work and associated sea turtle monitoring at Jupiter and extends the Agreement three (3) months to February 28, 2008. The County's match for this Amendment is 50% of the non-federal project costs, or \$345,254, which is already budgeted in the program budget. <u>Countywide</u> (SF)

Background and Justification: The original Grant Agreement provided FDEP funding for the purchase of over 125,000 tons of sand and the associated cost of placement for severe dune erosion at Lantana, Singer Island and South Palm Beach resulting from Sub-Tropical Storm Andrea earlier this year. Sub-Tropical Storm Andrea caused significant erosion of beaches and dunes sufficient to damage public facilities and threaten public infrastructure in two (2) public parks and threaten private property and residences. The storm exacerbated existing erosion problems in Jupiter, Singer Island, South Palm Beach and Lantana, which made them vulnerable **(Continued on page 3)**

to future storms. The State of Florida issued a declaration of shoreline emergency on May 14, 2007. This declaration listed several Palm Beach County erosion control projects including South Palm Beach and Singer Island Dune Restoration Projects and Jupiter Beach Park. Restoration work at Singer Island and South Palm Beach/Lantana is complete; however, sea turtle monitoring at Singer Island is ongoing until October 31, 2007. Sea turtle monitoring in Jupiter is also ongoing and a modified dune restoration was completed in late June. The FDEP is adding funding for the Jupiter project to the grant to fund the modified project and also for the full-scale dune restoration project which is permitted to begin after the end of sea turtle season (November 1, 2007). In addition, FDEP has committed to a cost-share on dune restoration projects commensurate with the public beach access and parking for each project area as authorized in 62B-36 F.A.C. The Jupiter portion of the project is eligible for a 50% cost-share based on available information.

AMENDMENT No: 1 DEP AGREEMENT No: 07PB2 FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION BUREAU OF BEACHES AND COASTAL SYSTEMS BEACH MANAGEMENT FUNDING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM STATE OF FLORIDA GRANT AGREEMENT FOR 2007 EMERGENCY DUNE NOURISHMENT PROJECT

THIS AGREEMENT entered into on the 19TH day of June, 2007, between the FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (hereinafter referred to as the "DEPARTMENT") and the PALM BEACH COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS a local government, (hereinafter referred to as the "LOCAL SPONSOR"), is hereby amended as follows:

- Paragraphs 1, 2, 7 and 8 are hereby revised to read as follows:
- 1. The DEPARTMENT does hereby retain the LOCAL SPONSOR to implement the beach erosion control project known as the 2007 EMERGENCY DUNE NOURISHMENT PROJECT, (hereafter referred to as the PROJECT), as defined in Attachment A-1 (Project Work Plan and Scope of Work), attached hereto and made a part hereof, and the LOCAL SPONSOR does hereby agree to perform such services as are necessary to implement the PROJECT in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement, and all attachments and exhibits named herein that are attached hereto and incorporated by reference. For purposes of this Agreement, the terms "Contract" and "Agreement" are used interchangeably, and the terms "Grantee", "Recipient" and "Local Sponsor" are used interchangeably.
- 2. This Agreement shall begin on the last date executed and end on February 28, 2008. Pursuant to Section 161.101 (18), Florida Statutes, work conducted on this project by the LOCAL SPONSOR or its subcontractor beginning on or after May 14, 2007, shall be eligible for cost sharing by the DEPARTMENT.
- The DEPARTMENT and the LOCAL SPONSOR agree that the estimated costs of the PROJECT are identified in Table 1 below: TABLE 1

PROJECT WORK PLAN AND SCOPE OF WORK

2007 EMERGENCY DUNE NOURISHMENT PROJECT

The PROJECT consists of dune restoration at Singer Island (500' South of R60 to 350' South of R68) and South Palm Beach (500' North of R136 to 400' South of R137). The PROJECT is in response to subtropical storm Andrea and the subsequent issuance of the DEPARTMENT's emergency order [OGC No. 07-0819]. The PROJECT shall be conducted in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth under this Agreement, all applicable DEP permits and the eligible project task items established below. All data collection and processing, and the resulting product deliverables, shall comply with the standard technical specifications contained in the Department's Regional Data Collection and Processing Plan and Geographic Information System Plan, unless otherwise specified in the approved Scope of Work for an eligible PROJECT item. These plans may be found at http://www.dep.state.fl.us/beaches/. Three (3) originals and one (1) electronic copy of all written reports developed under this Agreement shall be forwarded to the Department, unless otherwise specified.

Task No: Eligible Project Item:

3.0 Construction

Work performed and costs incurred associated with the placement of fill material and/or the construction of erosion control structures within the project area. Eligible costs may include mobilization, demobilization, construction observation or inspection services, beach fill, tilling and scarp removal, erosion control structures, dune stabilization measures and native beach-dune vegetation. Construction shall be conducted in accordance with any and all permits issued by the Department.

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into between the FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (hereinafter referred to as the "DEPARTMENT") whose address is 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000 and the PALM BEACH COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, whose address is 2300 North Jog Road, 4th Floor, West Palm Beach, Florida 33441-2743, a local government, (hereinafter referred to as the "LOCAL SPONSOR"), for the project described herein.

WHEREAS, the DEPARTMENT, pursuant to Section 161.091 - Section 161.161, Florida Statutes, provides financial assistance to eligible governmental entities for beach erosion control activities under the Florida Beach Management Funding Assistance Program; and,

WHEREAS, the LOCAL SPONSOR has the capabilities of performing the tasks associated with, and has demonstrated a financial commitment to, the beach erosion control project as described herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual benefits to be derived herefrom, the DEPARTMENT and the LOCAL SPONSOR do hereby agree as follows:

- 1. The DEPARTMENT does hereby retain the LOCAL SPONSOR to implement the beach erosion control project known as the 2007 EMERGENCY DUNE NOURISHMENT PROJECT, (hereafter referred to as the PROJECT), as defined in Attachment A (Project Work Plan), attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, and the LOCAL SPONSOR does hereby agree to perform such services as are necessary to implement the PROJECT in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement, and all attachments and exhibits named herein which are attached hereto and incorporated by reference. For purposes of this Agreement, the terms "Contract" and "Agreement" are used interchangeably, and the terms "Grantee", "Recipient" and "Local Sponsor" are used interchangeably.
- 2. This Agreement shall begin on the last date executed and end on December 1, 2007. Pursuant to Section 161.101 (18), Florida Statutes, work conducted on this project by the LOCAL SPONSOR or its subcontractor beginning on or after May 14, 2007, shall be eligible for cost sharing by the DEPARTMENT.
- 3. The LOCAL SPONSOR shall perform the services in a proper and satisfactory manner as determined by the DEPARTMENT. Any and all equipment, products or materials necessary to perform these services, or requirements as further stated herein, shall be supplied by the LOCAL SPONSOR.
- 4. The State of Florida's performance and obligation to pay under this Agreement is contingent upon an annual appropriation by the Legislature and subject to the release of funds appropriated to the DEPARTMENT.

- 5. The LOCAL SPONSOR shall implement the PROJECT and complete said PROJECT upon the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement and future requisite authorizations and environmental permits. The PROJECT consists of dune restoration at Singer Island (500' South of R60 to 350' South of R68) and South Palm Beach (500' North of R136 to 400' South of R137). The PROJECT is in response to subtropical storm Andrea and the subsequent issuance of the DEPARTMENT's emergency order [OGC No. 07-0819]. The life of the PROJECT is defined as ten (10) years commencing upon execution of this Agreement and re-initiated upon execution of subsequent amendments to this Agreement for additional funding. The parties expressly agree that the provisions of this paragraph shall survive and be enforceable beyond the expiration date of this Agreement.
- 6. The LOCAL SPONSOR shall develop a detailed Scope of Work for each eligible PROJECT task, as specified in Table 1 below. It is understood and agreed that the detailed Scope of Work shall include a narrative description of each task, a corresponding detailed budget and a project schedule. Written authorization to initiate each scope of work must be obtained from the DEPARTMENT prior to the initiation of said task. Failure to obtain prior written authorization for a specific task may result in the forfeiture of all retained funds associated with the PROJECT.

The DEPARTMENT and the LOCAL SPONSOR agree that the estimated costs of the PROJECT are identified in Table 1 below:

- 8. The DEPARTMENT's financial obligation shall not exceed the sum of \$1,033,594 for this PROJECT or up to 38.6 percent of the non-federal project cost, if applicable, for tasks 3.1 and 4.1, whichever is less; and up to 50 percent of the non-federal project cost, if applicable, for task 3.2, whichever is less. To the extent applicable, it is understood and agreed that for portions of the PROJECT which are located within lands owned and managed by the DEPARTMENT's Division of Recreation and Parks, no cost share for construction activities shall be required of the LOCAL SPONSOR, and the PROJECT costs for such portions shall be paid by the DEPARTMENT.
- 9. The DEPARTMENT and the LOCAL SPONSOR agree that any and all activities associated with the PROJECT that are not shown in Table 1 are the responsibility of the LOCAL SPONSOR and are not a part of this Agreement. The LOCAL SPONSOR agrees that any costs for the specific eligible project items which exceed the estimated project costs for that item shall be the responsibility of the LOCAL SPONSOR. Any modifications to the estimated TOTAL PROJECT COSTS shall be provided through formal amendment to this Agreement.
- 10. The LOCAL SPONSOR shall perform as an independent contractor and not as an agent, representative, or employee of the DEPARTMENT.

2007 EMERGENCY DUNE NOURISHMENT PROJECT

The PROJECT consists of dune restoration at Singer Island (500' South of R60 to 350' South of R68) and South Palm Beach (500' North of R136 to 400' South of R137). The PROJECT is in response to subtropical storm Andrea and the subsequent issuance of the DEPARTMENT's emergency order [OGC No. 07-0819]. The PROJECT shall be conducted in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth under this Agreement, all applicable DEP permits and the eligible project task items established below. All data collection and processing, and the resulting product deliverables, shall comply with the standard technical specifications contained in the Department's Regional Data Collection and Processing Plan and Geographic Information System Plan, unless otherwise specified in the approved Scope of Work for an eligible PROJECT item. These plans may be found at http://www.dep.state.fl.us/beaches/. Three (3) originals and one (1) electronic copy of all written reports developed under this Agreement shall be forwarded to the Department, unless otherwise specified.

Task No: Eligible Project Item:

3.0 Construction

Work performed and costs incurred associated with the placement of fill material and/or the construction of erosion control structures within the project area. Eligible costs may include mobilization, demobilization, construction observation or inspection services, beach fill, tilling and scarp removal, erosion control structures, dune stabilization measures and native beach-dune vegetation. Construction shall be conducted in accordance with any and all permits issued by the Department.
