Background and Justification: The Paul Coverdell National Forensic Science Improvement Act (NFSIA), became Public Law 106-561 on December 21, 2000. This Act authorized grants to states to improve the quality, timeliness, and credibility of forensic science services for criminal justice purposes. In general, the NFSIA program provides funding to crime laboratories and medical examiner's offices through the State Administering Agency (SAA) based on population and crime statistics. The program provides funding for expenses related to facilities, personnel, equipment, computerization, supplies, accreditation, certification, and education and training. The Technical Services Division of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office presented a proposal to NIJ entitled "Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement". The Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) number is 16.560 and the grant number is 2005-DN-BX-0073.

I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF


Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: Grant Adjustment Notice amending the Florida Department of Law Enforcement's Florida Consortium "Paul Coverdell National Forensic Sciences Improvement Act" Grant to extend the ending grant period from March 31, 2007 to September 30, 2007.

Summary: The Board of County Commissioners accepted this grant on April 18, 2006 (R- 2006-0715). The National Institute of Justice (NIJ) awarded funds to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) under the "Paul Coverdell National Forensic Sciences Improvement Act". This award will be used to pay overtime to evidence personnel to improve the status of the impound lot, perform a complete inventory of all evidence and input old cases in to the electronic evidence database Justice Trax-LIMS plus. This grant will also be used to purchase bicycle racks, barcode printers, and a hand held computer for evidence reconciliation and provide funds for a towing company to rearrange vehicles in the impound lot. The Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office has been given an extension to allow the grant funds to be fully expended. There is no grant match required, nor are any County funds required in FY 2007. 




