I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Change Order No. 6 to the Contract with R.J. Sullivan, Corp. (R2006-0780) for the Water Treatment Plant No. 8 Expansion Project increasing the contract price by \$106,992 and providing a twenty one (21) day time extension.

Change Order No. 6 authorizes the Contractor to perform Phase II Hurricane Summary: Hardening (Sodium Hypochlorite and Vacuum Filter Buildings) various civil, mechanical, and electrical improvements, resolve conflicts with the proposed new facilities, and comply with Building Department permit conditions. It also provides the Contractor with additional time (21 days) to accomplish the additional work. The hurricane hardening includes shutters, impact resistant windows and concrete walls to make the above referenced buildings hurricane resistant. Other revisions are to relocate an electrical ductbank which was in conflict with the proposed Filter Building and to provide a conduit for instrumentation wiring for the new Sludge Thickener and Sodium Hypochlorite Storage Tank. Also included is a credit for a water softening unit which can be eliminated. Total change orders to date, excluding the \$1,712,386.46 sales tax recovery program change order, equal \$928,559.85 (5.10% increase). The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance is 15.0% overall. This change order includes zero overall SBE participation. The contractor's cumulative SBE participation, including this change order, is 26.22% overall. (WUD Project No. 05-146) District 2 (JM)

Background and Justification: The Water Treatment Plant No. 8 Expansion will provide an additional 10 million gallons per day of potable water to accommodate existing and future customers. On May 2, 2006, the Board approved the construction contract with R.J. Sullivan Corp. (R2006-0780). This change order will authorize hurricane hardening for the Sodium Hypochlorite and Vacuum Filter Buildings which is prudent to prepare for category 4 or 5 storms, the relocation of an electrical ductbank which is in conflict with the proposed plant Filter Building and electrical conduit for the sodium hypochlorite storage tank and sludge thickener instrumentation wiring.



SCOPE OF WORK

- 6.1 <u>Furnish & Install (F&I) Electrical Ductbank to Permanently Replace the Temporary Wiring for the CO2 System (Differing Site Conditions) Excavation in the location of the new Filter building revealed an existing ductbank for the CO2 System which was in conflict with the new Filter building. In a previous change order, the ductbank was removed and temporary direct bury wiring was installed to keep the CO2 system up and running during construction of the Filter Building. The work in this C.O. is to install a new permanent ductbank to replace the temporary wiring installed previously.</u>
- 6.2 <u>F&I a 4-Inch Rigid Conduit in the Ductbank From RIO-2 in the Filter Building to Hand Hole 9B</u> (Errors/Omissions in Design) A conduit is required but not shown on the drawings for instrumentation wiring which is specified for the proposed sludge thickener and hypochlorite storage tank. Code requires this conduit to be installed in a ductbank.
- 6.3 <u>F&I Hurricane Hardening Improvements Shown on Sheets S-1 to S-9 of the Drawings Entitled</u> <u>"PHASE II: PROPOSED LOUVER SCREEN WALLS AND HURRICANE HARDENING" prepared by</u> <u>Bridge Design Associates, Dated June 13, 2007 (Owner Initiated) This enhancement at WTP 8 is in</u> conjunction with hurricane hardening projects at several of the WUD facilities and includes improvements such as structural walls, shutters and impact resistant windows to provide greater protection from hurricanes.
- 6.4 <u>Delete the Water Softener Specified for the Sodium Hypochlorite Generation System (Owner</u> Initiated) This change is a credit to delete a water softener which is not needed. The WTP 8 plant water system can provide water to the sodium hypochlorite generation system which meets the hardness requirements of the equipment.

As previously stated, this quotation does not include any electrical work. Since no electrical work is shown on the drawings, any electrical work required will be performed on a "Time & Material" basis. No new metal fascia panels are included. We plan to modify the existing panels to allow mounting of the new aluminum beams. The roll-up door proposed is a manually operated, insulated door. A non-insulated door would cost less. We plan to replace two broken panes of glass before application of the window film. The replacement glass will be similar to the other replacement glass that has already been installed.

If you would like for us to perform this extra work, please issue your written acceptance of our proposal and authorization to proceed.

Please also note that our original proposal was submitted on July 5, 2007. We have also been told not to proceed with construction on the Phase 1 Hurricane Hardening project because the County has been unable to obtain permits. The crews that we planned to use to perform this work as well as the Phase 1 work are no longer needed on site for the original contract and will be transferred to another project. These delays will certainly impact the completion dates, and if not resolved very soon, will cause increases in the cost of this work. When we are finally released to perform the work, we will notify you of the actual impact on cost and time.
