

Background and Justification: The Treasure Coast Regional Planning Council Organizational Rules provide that the Board of County Commissioners appoint three (3) members and three (3) alternates to the Council each year. The only restriction on both the members and alternates is that they are elected officials. The Treasure Coast Regional Planning Council has requested the BCC appoint their members and alternates before the Council's annual meeting on December 14, 2007. The Council has also requested that the BCC ratify the Palm Beach County League of Cities members which were appointed at the League's annual meeting on November 28, 2007.

Subject: Annual Appointment of Council Members

Dear Chairperson Green:

In accordance with Council's Rules of Organization, the December meeting is designated as the Annual Meeting, at which time the appointment of all members and alternates is to occur. It is therefore requested that the Board of County Commissioners take the necessary action to appoint members and alternates for the upcoming year. In the case of Palm Beach County, eight members and eight alternates need to be appointed (three county, five municipal). It should be noted that all alternates must be elected officials.

Additionally, the bylaws do not specifically indicate that municipal appointments must be either appointed or approved by the County. Each county is assigned the number of appointments and the method for making the appointments is left to the discretion and cooperation of the local governments in the area.

It would be appreciated if the County would notify the Council of appointments, including mailing addresses and telephone numbers, as soon as possible, so that the agenda packet for the December meeting can be provided in a timely fashion.
