I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a First Amendment to the Agreement between Palm Beach County and Lion Country Safari for the Operation and Maintenance of Wastewater Treatment Facilities.

Summary: On December 5, 2006 (R06-2674), the County and Lion Country Safari, Inc. (LCS) entered into an agreement (Agreement) for the operation and maintenance of LCS' wastewater treatment facility. The Agreement is scheduled to expire December 4, 2007; however, LCS has the option to extend the Agreement for one (1) additional year if LCS commits, in writing and prior to December 5, 2007, to connect to the County's wastewater collection system. LCS has fulfilled the requirements to extend the Agreement. The Water Utilities Department requests Board approval in order to amend the Agreement and extend the expiration date through December 5, 2008, with an upward adjustment of 10% for all charges. Capital improvements required at the facilities are not included in this Agreement and either party may cancel the Agreement with a 90-day written notice. District 6 (MJ)

Background and Justification: The Water Utilities Department currently provides contract operations and maintenance services for water and wastewater treatment plants owned by Seminole Improvement District, the School Board, and the Department of Airports. LCS entered into an agreement to have the Department provide similar services for their treatment facilities in anticipation of connection to the County wastewater system. They will continue to pay for all direct costs, plus other fees at cost. Water Utilities Department staff will make scheduled routine visits for operation and maintenance purposes, provide necessary chemicals, provide testing services, and insure that the facilities meet permit requirements. Additional services that may be requested by Lion Country Safari will be billed for direct costs plus 25%.



WHEREAS, Owner and County previously entered into an Agreement for the Operation and Maintenance of Wastewater Treatment Facilities ("Agreement") (County Resolution No R2006-2674); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement will expire on December 4, 2007; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the terms of the Agreement, the Agreement may be extended for one additional year, but only if Owner has committed, in writing and prior to December 5, 2007, to permanently connect to County's wastewater system; and

WHEREAS, Owner has committed, in writing and prior to December 5, 2007, to permanently connect to the County's wastewater system, as set forth in the letter attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "1"; and

WHEREAS, County and Owner wish to extend the Agreement through December 4, 2008.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants herein contained, the parties hereby covenant and agree:

- 1. The foregoing statements are true and correct and are incorporated herein by specific reference.
- 2. The term of the Agreement is hereby extended for one additional year, to run through December 4, 2008. The rates for the period December 5, 2007 December 4, 2008, shall be increased by 10% as set forth in Section 5 of the Agreement.
- 3. All other provisions of the Agreement are hereby confirmed and, except as provided herein, are not otherwise altered or amended and shall remain in full force and effect.

Dear Bevin:

This letter confirms our intent to connect to PBC WUD wastewater system at the earliest feasible opportunity. Our commitment is subject to obtaining easements, construction permitting approvals, regulatory approvals and budgetary constraints.

Lion Country Safari has authorized William Reese, PE of Arcadis G&M, Inc to prepare the necessary engineering design drawings and to obtain all the applicable approvals and permits. I since have been informed by Arcadis that they have requested from the county a copy of the ITID agreement since they can not proceed with the design work without obtaining permission from ITID to do surveying and also boring tests. As of today they have not received any information and therefore no progress has been made on the design work. A copy of the memo dated August 21, 2007 is enclosed.

The construction of the proposed wastewater system improvements (including a lift station and a force main connecting to the existing PBC WUD owned force main on Seminole Pratt Whitney Road) can't be commenced until Arcadis has received the information they have requested.

I would appreciate it if you could provide Arcadis with all the necessary information, as we would like to proceed with the construction as soon as possible.
