I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

A) Amendment No. 2 to Grant Agreement No. 07PB2 (R2007-0988) with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) for additional cost-sharing in the amount of \$842,119 for a total of up to \$2,220,968 for the Emergency Dune Restoration;

B) Budget Amendment of \$842,119 in the Beach Improvement Fund to recognize the Amendment revenue in the Emergency Beach Response Program; and

C) Budget Transfer of \$1,237,170 within the Beach Improvement Fund from Reserves to the Emergency Beach Response Program.

Summary: Nearly all of the sand placed on the beach in response to Sub-Tropical Storm Andrea was eroded following an early October Nor'easter and Tropical Storm Noel. FDEP has authorized additional cost sharing to restore the sand lost from the dunes at Singer Island and South Palm Beach. The Grant Agreement and Budget Transfer provides funding from the FDEP (\$842,119) and Reserves for Beach Improvements (\$1,237,170) for a total of \$2,079,289 added to the Emergency Beach Response Program for the purchase, delivery and placement of over 125,000 tons of sand. The County's match for this Amendment is 50% of the project costs at South Palm Beach, or \$173,306, and 61.4% of the project costs at Singer Island, or \$1,063,864. Countywide (SF)

Background and Justification: On June 19, 2007, the Board approved FDEP Grant Agreement No. 07PB2 (R2007-0988) for \$1,033,594 in emergency beach funding for Lantana, Singer Island and South Palm Beach. Amendment No. 1 was executed November 20, 2007 and provided additional FDEP funding of up to \$345,255 for dune work and associated sea turtle monitoring at Jupiter and extended the Agreement three (3) months to February 28, 2008. This amendment complies with our review requirements.

(Background and Justification continued from page 1):

Wind and waves associated with the early October Nor'easter and Tropical Storm Noel caused significant erosion of beaches and dunes sufficient to damage public facilities and threaten public infrastructure. The storm exacerbated existing erosion problems in Jupiter, Singer Island, South Palm Beach and Lantana, which made them vulnerable to future storms. FDEP has committed to a cost-share on dune restoration projects commensurate with the public beach access and parking for each project area as authorized in 62B-36 F.A.C. The following cost shares have been calculated based on available information:

Singer Island – 38.6% South Palm Beach – 50%

This dune restoration project is expected to cost approximately \$1,732,677 for the Singer Island project, and \$346,612 for the South Palm Beach/Lantana project.

AMENDMENT No: 2 DEP AGREEMENT No: 07PB2 FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION BUREAU OF BEACHES AND COASTAL SYSTEMS BEACH MANAGEMENT FUNDING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM STATE OF FLORIDA GRANT AGREEMENT FOR 2007 EMERGENCY DUNE NOURISHMENT PROJECT

THIS AGREEMENT entered into on the 19TH day of June, 2007, and amended on the 20TH day of November, 2007, between the FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (hereinafter referred to as the "DEPARTMENT") and the PALM BEACH COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, a local government (hereinafter referred to as the "LOCAL SPONSOR"), is hereby amended as follows:

- Paragraphs 2, 5, 7 and 8 are hereby revised to read as follows:
- 2. This Agreement shall begin on the last date executed and end on February 29, 2008. Pursuant to Section 161.101 (18), Florida Statutes, work conducted on this project by the LOCAL SPONSOR or its subcontractor beginning on or after May 14, 2007, may be eligible for cost sharing by the DEPARTMENT.
- 5. The LOCAL SPONSOR shall implement the PROJECT and complete said PROJECT upon the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement and future requisite authorizations and environmental permits. The PROJECT consists of dune nourishment at Singer Island (500 feet south of R60 to 350 feet south of R68), South Palm Beach (500 feet north of R136 to 400 feet south of R137) and Jupiter Beach (200' south of R13 to 850' south of R17). The original agreement and Amendment No. 1 to the 07PB2 Contract were for dune nourishment work due to erosion from Subtropical Storm Andrea. This Amendment (Amendment 2) is generated for work associated with Tropical Storm Noel and the northeasterly winds which caused severe beach erosion within the above areas, during the winter of 2007. The life of the PROJECT is defined as ten (10) years commencing upon execution of this Agreement and re-initiated upon execution of subsequent amendments to this Agreement for additional funding. The parties expressly agree that the provisions of this paragraph shall survive and be enforceable beyond the expiration date of this Agreement.
- 7. The DEPARTMENT and the LOCAL SPONSOR agree that the estimated costs of the PROJECT are identified in Table 1 below:

The DEPARTMENT's financial obligation shall not exceed the sum of \$2,220,968 for this PROJECT or up to 38.6 percent of the non-federal project cost, if applicable, for tasks 3.1, 3.4 and 4.1; and up to 50 percent of the non-federal project cost, if applicable, for tasks 3.2, 3.3, 3.5 and 4.2, whichever is less. To the extent applicable, it is understood and agreed that for portions of the PROJECT which are located within lands owned and managed by the DEPARTMENT's Division of Recreation and Parks, no cost share for construction activities shall be required of the LOCAL SPONSOR, and the PROJECT costs for such portions shall be paid by the DEPARTMENT.
- All references to Attachment A-1 is hereby deleted and replaced with references to Attachment A-2.
- Attachment A-1 is hereby deleted in its entirety.
- Attachment A-2 as attached hereto is hereby added to the Agreement.

PROJECT WORK PLAN

2007 EMERGENCY DUNE NOURISHMENT PROJECT

The PROJECT consists of dune nourishment at Singer Island (500 feet south of R60 to 350 feet south of R68), South Palm Beach (500 feet north of R136 to 400 feet south of R137 and Jupiter Beach (200' south of R13 to 850' south of R17). The original agreement and Amendment No. 1 to the Contract (07PB2) were in regards to Subtropical Storm Andrea. This Amendment (Amendment 2) is generated for works associated with Tropical Storm Noel and the northeasterly winds which caused severe beach erosion within the above areas, during the winter of 2007.. The PROJECT shall be conducted in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth under this Agreement, all applicable Department of Environmental Protection permits and the eligible project task items established below. All data collection and processing, and the resulting product deliverables, shall comply with the standard technical specifications contained in the Department's Regional Data Collection and Processing Plan and Geographic Information System Plan, unless otherwise specified in the approved Scope of Work (hereinafter referred to as SOW) for an eligible PROJECT item. These plans may be found at <u>http://www.dep.state.fl.us/beaches/</u>. Three (3) originals and one (1) electronic copy of all written reports developed under this Agreement shall be forwarded to the Department, unless otherwise specified.

Task No: Eligible Project Item:

3.0 Construction

Work performed and costs incurred associated with the placement of fill material and/or the construction of erosion control structures within the project area. Eligible costs may include mobilization, demobilization, construction observation or inspection services, beach fill, tilling and scarp removal, erosion control structures, dune stabilization measures and native beach-dune vegetation. Construction shall be conducted in accordance with any and all permits issued by the Department.

3.1 Singer Island Construction

A total of eight bids for construction were submitted by Palm Beach County to DEP for the Singer Island Emergency Dune Construction. The table below lists the eight bids reviewed and approved by DEP:

3.3 Jupiter Beach Park Construction

CCCL Permit (PB-897) was used to set the project boundary limits (200' south of R13 to 850' south of R17) for this contract amendment (Amendment No. 1, 07PB2). Currently, a separate CCCL Emergency Permit (PB-899E) was established with more restrictive project boundary limits (200' south of R13 to 500' south of R14). Placement of sand is limited to within these permit (PB-899E) boundaries, through the end of turtle season, November 1, 2007.

3.4 Singer Island Dune Construction – Winter 2007

Sand will be truck hauled from a sand mining facility to the project area. The work must be completed by the beginning of sea turtle nesting season beginning March 1, 2008. No dune plantings will be authorized for cost-sharing during 2008 season. The estimated costs for the projected dune nourishment are given in the table below:

4.0 Monitoring

A monitoring program conducted in accordance with the requirements specified in any and all permits issued by the Department and the US Army Corps of Engineers. A monitoring plan must be submitted and approved in writing by the Department prior to the initiation of monitoring activities. The plan shall be developed in a manner which will coordinate the monitoring activities associated with current shoreline stabilization projects located within or adjacent to the project area and with the Department's Regional Coastal Monitoring Program.
