

Note 2:

The bid opening date for this project was on <u>July 24, 2007</u>. Since the contract will be awarded on a date more than 90 days after the bid opening date, and since the applicable wage decision previously transmitted to you has been changed, you must incorporate the change into the contract documents. - 3. <u>Pre-Construction Conference:</u> Please invite HCD to the project pre-construction conference. Please notify HCD, at 233-3614, at least three working days before the pre-construction conference date.
- 4. <u>Notice to Proceed:</u> Please provide this office a copy of the Notice to Proceed <u>in electronic form</u> when it is issued by your department.
- 5. <u>Subcontractor Required Forms:</u> Please provide HCD with completed copies of the Certification Regarding Debarment, Suspension, Ineligibility, and Voluntary Exclusion Lower Tier Participant (copy enclosed), for each subcontractor.
- Construction Schedule: The State requires, within thirty (30) days from the execution of the
 construction contract, that the prime contractor submit a schedule for the completion of the
 construction work under the contract. Please obtain such a schedule from the contractor
 and provide a copy to HCD.
- 7. <u>Engineer's Certification:</u> The State requires the submission of a written certification from the project engineer upon completion of the project. Please provide HCD such certification indicating that the project has met the specifications of the design (as amended by change order), and indicating the date of completion of construction.
- 8. Contractual Obligations and MBE Report: Please note that the "Requirements for Federally Funded Projects" included in the construction contract require the prime contractor to submit the enclosed Contractual Obligations and MBE Report each March 31st and each September 30th. - 9. <u>Construction Retainage and Davis-Bacon Act Compliance:</u> Please apply a retainage of at least 5% to all construction draws. Retainages shall be released in conjunction with the final draw upon satisfactory completion of the project. Also, please <u>do not</u> release such retainages until you have obtained approval from the HCD that the contractor and subcontractors have complied with the requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act.


