### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: First Amendment to Agreement (R2007-1734) with South Florida Science Museum, Inc. for the 2007 Summer Camp Program.

**Summary:** This fully executed First Amendment to Agreement in an amount not-to-exceed \$10,000 expands the project time frame from June 4, 2007 through August 21, 2007, to May 1, 2007 through April 1, 2008, and extends the term of the Agreement from November 21, 2007, to April 1, 2008 in order to allow additional time to accommodate dates of payments and complete the reimbursement process. The Amendment is in accordance with Resolution R2005-1738 authorizing the delegation of authority for amending RAP agreements to the County Administrator or his designee. All other terms of the Agreement, including the funding amount of \$10,000, remain the same. Funding for the project is from the Recreation Assistance Program (RAP) District 2 Funds. <u>District 2</u> (AH)

**Background and Justification:** Resolution R-2005-1738 was adopted by the Board on September 13, 2005, to streamline the RAP reimbursement process. It establishes terms and conditions for amending RAP projects and delegates authority for the execution of the amendments to the County Administrator or his designee, which is the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department. The criteria for delegated signature of amendments on behalf of the Board include:

- Changes in project scope/elements within the intent of the approved RAP project;
- Adjustments in budgetary line items within the intent of the approved RAP Project which do not change the contractual amount;
- Changes to the approved project time frame including the initiation date and/or project completion date for periods of less than one year; and
- Other miscellaneous modifications approved by the awarding Commissioner within the overall intent of the approved RAP project.

This delegation of authority allows for more efficient and timely reimbursements for RAP projects by streamlining the existing RAP process for amendments to agreements. The attached Amendment meets criteria listed above, and was executed on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners by the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department.

# FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND SOUTH FLORIDA SCIENCE MUSEUM, INC. FOR FUNDING OF THE 2007 SUMMER CAMP PROGRAM

THIS AMENDMENT is entered into on 2-7-08, by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "County", and South Florida Science Museum, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit corporation, herein referred to as "Science Museum".

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2007, COUNTY entered into an Agreement (R-2007-1734) with Science Museum, hereinafter referred to as "Agreement" to provide Recreation Assistance Program (RAP) funding in an amount not to exceed \$10,000 to assist with the cost of the 2007 Summer Camp Program, hereinafter referred to as the "Project"; and

WHEREAS, Science Museum has requested that County extend the Project time frame and completion date from June 4, 2007, through November 21, 2007, to May 1, 2007, through April 1, 2008, in order to allow for additional time to accommodate dates of payment and completion of the reimbursement process; and

WHEREAS, the Project will benefit all citizens of Palm Beach County.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the parties hereby agree as follows:

- 1. Section 3 of the Agreement is amended to read "Science Museum incurred expenses for the Project beginning on May 1, 2007. Those costs incurred by Science Museum for the Project, approved and submitted accordingly by Science Museum subsequent to May 1, 2007, are eligible for reimbursement by County pursuant to the terms and conditions hereof."
- 1. Section 8 of the Agreement is amended to read "The term of this Agreement shall be until April 1, 2008, commencing upon the date of execution by the parties hereto".
- 2. Section 11 of the Agreement is amended to read "Science Museum shall complete the project by April 1, 2008, and invoices and checks and/or proof of payments submitted for reimbursement must be dated within the Project time frame of May 1, 2007, through April 1, 2008. Science Museum shall provide its final reimbursement request(s), including a project completion statement and reimbursement documentation as indicated in Section 2 above on or before April 1, 2008."
- 3. Except as provided herein, each and every other term of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and the Agreement is reaffirmed as modified herein.
