LEGAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, dated this 11th day of March 2008 by and between PALM BEACH COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and the Office of the Public Defender, Fifteenth Judicial Circuit, a Florida Constitutional Officer, hereinafter referred to as OFFICE.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties agree to enter into this Agreement of March 11, 2008 under which the OFFICE agrees to operate a pilot project in the Ex-Offender Re-Entry Program for Florida identification cards for newly released inmates from the county jail; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY agrees to reimburse the OFFICE from the local Crime Prevention Trust Fund (CPTF) for operating expenses and supplies; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreement expressed herein, the COUNTY and OFFICE agree as follows:

- 1. The term of Agreement is from January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008.
- 2. The total amount to be paid by the COUNTY for all services for the period January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008 under this Agreement shall not exceed Seven Thousand Dollars (\$7,000) from the COUNTY'S Crime Prevention Trust Funds.
- 3. Both the COUNTY and the OFFICE agree to be governed by this Agreement, as well as applicable State laws, rules and regulations.
- 4. Modification of this Agreement may be requested by either party. Changes which are mutually agreed upon shall be valid only when reduced to writing, duly signed by each party and attached to the original Agreement.
- 5. The funding will be used to secure identification cards from the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles and any necessary support documentation for these identification cards for inmates preparing for release from the Palm Beach County jail facilities.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida has made and executed this Contract on behalf of the COUNTY and OFFICE has hereunto set its hand the day and year above written.
