The County has encumbered \$385,060 (\$35,006/month) during the previous eleven (11) months of the current twelve (12) month term contract. Based upon historical usage, a four percent (4%) increase in unit prices and replacement of approximately 200 sets of existing bunker gear, \$500,000 is needed to meet the County's requirements through the expiration of this twelve (12) month renewal term contract. This is a sole-source provider who is not a certified SBE.

The County has encumbered \$1,912,178 (\$86,917/month) during the previous twenty-two (22) months of the current twenty-four (24) month term contact. Due to the decision of Office Depot to not renew this contract, the encumbered amount, minus the non-renewed lots/locales, equates to \$1,362,841 (\$61,947/month) for renewal purposes. Based upon the adjusted historical usage, \$743,370 is needed to meet the County's requirements through the expiration of this twelve (12) month renewal contract. The non-renewed lots/locales are currently being rebid. This term contract has three (3) twelve (12) month renewal options remaining.

This term contract has three (3) twelve (12) month renewal options remaining. No certified SBE vendor bid within 10% of the low bidder.

This is a sole source provider who is not a certified SBE.

Based upon historical usage and an increased need for Microsoft licenses and various product purchases, \$495,000 is needed to meet the County's requirements through the expiration of this twelve (12) month renewal term contract. This term contract has no renewal options remaining. This purchase is off State of Florida contract #255-001-01-1 due to the lack of SBE competition for this commodity.
