I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Agreement with Young Singers of the Palm Beaches, Inc. for the period April 1, 2008, through August 31, 2008, in an amount not-to-exceed \$2,000 for funding of a performance tour to the Children in Harmony Choral Festival.

Summary: This funding is to help offset costs for Young Singers of the Palm Beaches, Inc.'s performance tour to the Children in Harmony Choral Festival at Walt Disney World from May 22, through May 25, 2008. Approximately 50 children and youth will participate in the tour. Funding is from Recreation Assistance Program (RAP) District 2 Funds. <u>District 7</u> (AH)

Background and Justification: Young Singers of the Palm Beaches, Inc. (YSPB) is a not-for-profit organization whose mission is to train and provide the highest possible standard of vocal and musical training for children and youth in Palm Beach County. YSPB is the only stand-alone community children's choir in Palm Beach County that is not affiliated with any religious organization or school and is operated by a high quality, professional staff of music educators. Children and youth participating in YSPB's Children's Community Choir come from throughout Palm Beach County and represent a diverse cultural and socio-economic make-up.

Fifty young singers from the Children's Community Choir will be participate in the Performance Tour to represent Palm Beach County at the prestigious Children in Harmony Choral Festival at Walt Disney World in Orlando, Florida. The children and youth will join with other young singers from all over the country to sing, learn together and from each other, and perform in a public concert at Walt Disney World.

The performance tour to the Children in Harmony Choral Festival is estimated to cost approximately \$27,000 for music, hotel expenses, rehearsal expenses, and other miscellaneous expenses associated with the Performance Tour. The \$2,000 District 2 RAP allocation will help offset a portion of these expenses. The Agreement has been executed on behalf of Young Singers of the Palm Beaches, Inc., and now needs to be approved by the Board of County Commissioners.

AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND YOUNG SINGERS OF THE PALM BEACHES, INC. FOR THE PERFORMANCE TOUR TO THE CHILDREN IN HARMONY CHORAL FESTIVAL

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into on ______, by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "County", and Young Singers of the Palm Beaches, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit corporation authorized to do business in the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "YSPB".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, YSPB's mission is to train and provide the highest possible standard of vocal and musical training for children in Palm Beach County from ages eight (8) through eighteen (18); and

WHEREAS, YSPB is the only stand-alone community children's choir in Palm Beach
County not affiliated with any religious organization or school and operated by a high
quality, professional staff of music educators; and

WHEREAS, the children participating in the Children's Community Choir come from throughout Palm Beach County and represent a diverse cultural and socio-economic make up; and

WHEREAS, fifty (50) young singers from YSPB will be representing Palm Beach County at the prestigious Children in Harmony Choral Festival at Walt Disney World in Orlando from May 22 through May 25, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Performance Tour will bring singers from all over the country to sing, learn together from each other, and YSPB singers will represent Palm Beach County in a public concert at Disney World; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the Performance Tour is estimated to be approximately \$27,000 for music, hotel expenses, rehearsal expenses, and other miscellaneous expenses associated with the Performance Tour; and

WHEREAS, YSPB has requested funding in the amount of \$2,000 to help offset costs for the Performance Tour; and

WHEREAS, funding for the Performance Tour in the amount of \$2,000 is available from the Recreation Assistance Program (RAP) – District 2 (\$2,000); and

WHEREAS, participation of children and youth in music and cultural programs to serves a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, both parties desire to enter into this Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants and promises contained herein, the parties hereby agree to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. County agrees to fund an amount not to exceed \$2,000 to YSPB for the Performance Tour to the Children in Harmony Choral Festival in Orlando for music, hotel expenses, rehearsal expenses, and other miscellaneous expenses associated with the Performance Tour as set forth in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein, hereinafter referred to as the "Project".
- 2. County will use its best efforts to provide said funds to YSPB on a reimbursement basis within forty-five (45) days of receipt of the following information:
- a. A written statement that the Project, as specified herein, was carried out in accordance with this Agreement; and
- b. A Contract Payment Request Form and a Contractual Services Purchases Schedule Form attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "B", which are required for each and every reimbursement requested by YSPB. Said information shall list each invoice paid by YSPB and shall include the vendor invoice number; invoice date; and the amount paid by YSPB along with the number and date of the respective check or proof of payment for said payment. YSPB shall attach a copy of each vendor invoice paid by YSPB along with a copy of the respective check or proof of payment and shall make reference thereof to the applicable item listed on the Contractual Services Purchases Schedule. Further, YSPB's Program Administrator and Project Financial Officer shall certify the total funds spent by YSPB on the Project and shall also certify that each vendor invoice, as listed on the Contractual Services Purchases Schedule was paid by YSPB and approved by YSPB as indicated.
- 3. YSPB incurred expenses for the Project beginning on April 10, 2008. Those costs incurred by YSPB for the Project, approved and submitted accordingly by YSPB subsequent to April 10, 2008, are eligible for reimbursement by County pursuant to the terms and conditions hereof.
- 4. RAP funds may be used as a match for other local, state, or federal grant programs, but YSPB may not submit reimbursement requests for the same expenses to the County as other fund sources to receive duplicate reimbursement for the same expenses.
- 5. YSPB warrants that it is an active not-for-profit corporation, duly chartered and registered with the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations.

- 6. YSPB agrees, warrants, and represents that all of the employees and participants in the Project will be treated equally during employment, and for the provision of services without regard to residency, race, color, religion, disability, sex, age, national origin, ancestry, marital status, or sexual orientation.
- 7. YSPB shall be responsible for operation and maintenance of the Project, including all associated costs.
- 8. The term of this Agreement shall be until August 31, 2008, commencing upon the date of execution by the parties hereto.
- 9. The parties agree that, in the event YSPB is in default of its obligations under this Agreement, the County shall provide YSPB thirty (30) days written notice to cure the default. In the event YSPB fails to cure the default within the thirty (30) day cure period, the County shall have no further obligation to honor reimbursement requests submitted by YSPB for the Project deemed to be in default and YSPB shall return any County RAP funds already collected by YSPB for that Project.
- 10. Notwithstanding any provision of this Agreement to the contrary, this Agreement may be terminated by the County, without cause, upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other party. This Agreement may be terminated by the County with cause, upon expiration of the thirty (30) day cure period provided for in Section 8 above.
- 11. YSPB shall complete the Project by May 31, 2008, and invoices and checks submitted for reimbursement must be dated within the project time frame of April 10, 2008, and May 31, 2008. YSPB shall provide its final reimbursement request(s), including a project completion statement and reimbursement documentation as indicated in Section 2 above on or before August 31, 2008. Upon written notification to County at least ninety (90) days prior to that date YSPB may request an extension beyond this period for the purpose of completing the Project. County shall not unreasonably deny YSPB's request for said extension.
- 12. In the event YSPB ceases to exist, or ceases or suspends the Project for any reason, any remaining unpaid portion of this Agreement shall be retained by County, and County shall have no further obligation to honor reimbursement requests submitted by YSPB. The determination that YSPB has ceased or suspended the Project shall be made by County and YSPB agrees to be bound by County's determination.
- 13. YSPB agrees to abide by, and be governed by, all applicable federal, state, county, and municipal laws, including but not limited to, Palm Beach County's ordinances,

as said laws and ordinances exist and are amended from time to time. In entering into this Agreement, Palm Beach County does not waive the requirements of any County or local ordinance or the requirements of obtaining any permits or licenses normally required to conduct business or activity conducted by YSPB. Failure to comply may result in County's refusal to honor reimbursement requests for the Project.

14. County reserves the right to withhold reimbursement if the Project is not completed as specified in Exhibit "A".

15. It is understood and agreed that YSPB is merely a recipient of County funding and is an independent contractor and is not an agent, servant or employee of County or its Board of County Commissioners. It is further acknowledged that the County only contributes funding under this Agreement and operates no control over the Project. In the event a claim or lawsuit is brought against County or any of its officers, agents or employees, YSPB shall indemnify, save and hold harmless and defend the County, its officers, agents, and/or employees from and against any and all claims, liabilities, losses, judgments, and/or causes of action of any type arising out of or relating to any act or omission of YSPB, its agents, servants and/or employees in the performance of this Agreement. The foregoing indemnification shall survive termination of this Agreement.

In consideration for reimbursement of costs incurred prior to the term of this Agreement, the foregoing indemnification shall apply not only during the term of this Agreement but also for the period prior to the Agreement for which YSPB is eligible to receive reimbursement from the County.

16. YSPB shall, at its sole expense, agree to maintain in full force and effect at all times during the life of this Agreement, insurance coverages and limits (including endorsements), as described herein. YSPB shall agree to provide the County with at least ten (10) day prior notice of any cancellation, non-renewal, or material change to the insurance coverages. The requirements contained herein, as well as County's review and acceptance of insurance maintained by YSPB are not intended to and shall not in any manner limit or qualify the liabilities and obligations assumed by YSPB under this Agreement.

Commercial General Liability. YSPB shall maintain Commercial General Liability at a limit of liability not less than \$500,000 Each Occurrence. Coverage shall not contain any endorsement excluding Contractual Liability or Cross Liability unless granted in writing by County's Risk Management Department. YSPB shall provide

this coverage on a primary basis.

Worker's Compensation Insurance & Employer's Liability. YSPB shall maintain Worker's Compensation & Employers Liability in accordance with Florida Statute Chapter 440. YSPB shall provide this coverage on a primary basis.

Additional Insured. YSPB shall endorse the County as an Additional Insured with a CG 2026 Additional Insured - Designated Person or Organization endorsement, or its equivalent, to the Commercial General Liability. The Additional Insured endorsement shall read APalm Beach County Board of County Commissioners, a Political Subdivision of the State of Florida, its Officers, Employees and Agents.@ YSPB shall provide the Additional Insured endorsements coverage on a primary basis.

Waiver of Subrogation. YSPB hereby waives any and all rights of Subrogation against the County, its officers, employees and agents for each required policy. When required by the insurer, or should a policy condition not permit an insured to enter into a pre-loss agreement to waive subrogation without an endorsement, then YSPB shall agree to notify the insurer and request the policy be endorsed with a Waiver of Transfer of Rights of Recovery Against Others, or its equivalent. This Waiver of Subrogation requirement shall not apply to any policy when a condition to the policy specifically prohibits such an endorsement, or voids coverage should YSPB enter into such an agreement on a pre-loss basis.

Certificate(s) of Insurance. Prior to execution of this Agreement by the County, YSPB shall deliver to the County a Certificate(s) of coverage evidencing that all types and amounts of insurance coverages required by this Agreement have been obtained and are in full force and effect. Such Certificate(s) of Insurance shall include a minimum ten (10) day endeavor to notify due to cancellation or non-renewal of coverage. Certificate holder's address shall read Palm Beach County, c/o Parks and Recreation Department, 2700 Sixth Avenue South, Lake Worth, FL 33461, Attention: Administrative Support Manager.

Right to Review. County, by and through its Risk Management Department, in cooperation with the contracting/monitoring department, reserves the right to review, modify, reject or accept any required policies of insurance, including limits, coverages, or endorsements, herein from time to time throughout the term of this Agreement. County reserves the right, but not the obligation, to review and reject

any insurer providing coverage because of its poor financial condition or failure to operate legally.

17. Upon request by County, YSPB shall demonstrate financial accountability through the submission of acceptable financial audits performed by an independent auditor.

18. YSPB shall maintain books, records, documents and other evidence that sufficiently and properly reflect all costs of any nature expended in the performance of this Agreement for a period of not less than five (5) years. Upon advance notice to YSPB, County shall have the right to inspect and audit said books, records, documents and other evidence during normal business hours.

19. The County and YSPB may pursue any and all actions available under law to enforce this Agreement including, but not limited to, actions arising from the breach of any provision set forth herein.

20. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida and any and all legal action necessary to enforce this Agreement shall be held in Palm Beach County.

21. As provided in Section 287.132-133, Florida Statutes, by entering into this Agreement or performing any work in furtherance hereof, YSPB certifies that it, its affiliates, suppliers, subcontractors and consultants who will perform hereunder, have not been placed on the convicted vendor list maintained by the State of Florida Department of Management Services within the thirty six (36) months immediately preceding the date hereof. This notice is required by Section 287.133 (3) (a), Florida Statutes.

22. This Agreement represents the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all other negotiations, representations, or agreement, written or oral, relating to this Agreement. This Agreement may be modified and amended only by written instrument executed by the parties hereto.

23. Any notice given pursuant to the terms of this Agreement shall be in writing and hand delivered or sent by U.S. mail. All notices shall be addressed to the following:

24. This Agreement is made solely and specifically among and for the benefit of the parties hereto, and no other person shall have any rights, interest, or claims hereunder or be entitled to any benefits under or on account of this Agreement as a third-party beneficiary or otherwise.
