## I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: THE VOLUNTARY ANNEXATION OF A PARCEL OWNED BY PALM BEACH COUNTY INTO THE CITY OF WEST PALM BEACH.

Palm Beach County requests to voluntarily annex a county-owned property into the City of Summary: West Palm Beach. The 0.042-acre parcel, as described in Attachment A, is a county-owned lift station maintained by the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) and will otherwise be an unincorporated enclave when the adjacent property to the east is voluntarily annexed into the City. Pursuant to the Interlocal Agreement between Palm Beach County and the City of West Palm Beach regarding Water and Wastewater Service Area dated December 20, 2005 (County Resolution No. R2005-2445), the property is within the PBCWUD water and wastewater service area and will remain in the County's water and wastewater service area following the annexation. By signing the voluntary annexation petition, Palm Beach County does not transfer ownership rights for the parcel, but rather consents to the property being annexed into, and included within, the municipal boundary of the City of West Palm Beach. The annexation has been processed through the County's review departments, including Fire-Rescue, Engineering, Planning, Zoning, Environmental Resources Management, Parks and Recreation, Water Utilities, County Attorney, Property and Real Estate Management and the Office of Financial Management and Budget Departments. None of the departments are opposed to the annexation. The proposed annexation meets the requirements of Chapter 171, F. S. and is consistent with the Intergovernmental Coordination Element, Objective 1.4, of the County's Comprehensive Plan. District 2 (RB)

The Legislature recognizes that enclaves can create significant problems Background and Justification: in planning, growth management, and service delivery, and therefore declares that it is the policy of the state to eliminate enclaves. Palm Beach County requests to voluntarily annex a county-owned parcel into the City of West Palm Beach, as described in Attachment A. Pursuant to Section 11.2 of the County Resolution No. R2005-2445, the property will remain in PBCWUD's water and wastewater service area following proposed annexation. This unincorporated parcel is within the City's future annexation area. The proposed annexation meets the requirements of Chapter 171, F. S., for annexation and are consistent with the Intergovernmental Coordination Element, Objective 1.4, of the County's Comprehensive Plan, which supports municipal efforts to secure boundary changes that maintain cost-effective service delivery.
